Non-Refundable Deposit: ¹/₂ of total required within 10 days of registration to hold site.

"Shared Use" multiple reserved individuals/groups have access.

"<u>Private Use</u>" no other individuals/groups using specified facility, other campers may be present on site. "<u>Exclusive Presence</u>" no other reserved individuals/groups at the Camp (maintenance may be present) "<u>Complete Campsite Use</u>" <u>Exclusive Presence</u> and use of all Sites; Cabins, Lodge, Pavilion, Kitchen, Council Ring

Tent Site Use: (Bring your own Tent) 1 tent up to 4 occupants (\$5 per person daily for over 4 person limit) Electricity \$10 additional per day	\$25 (1-4 persons)	
Camper Site Use: (12' x 24' max) Includes 30 & 50 AMP Electrical (No Water or Waste Hookup)	\$40 (1-4 persons)	
Cabin Use: (Per Cabin) Cabins holds 1-14 persons each (Seven Bunk Beds)	\$100 (\$200 for both)	
Complete Camp Use: "Exclusive Presence" Tent, Camper, Cabin Sites; Lodge, Pavilion, Kitchen, Council Ring	\$400 (per night)	

Overnight Facilities Use: Those in Tents, Campers and/or Cabin Sites may reserve any/all of the Lodge, Pavilion, Kitchen and Council Ring **at \$25** each per day. This will be a "<u>Private Use</u>" of the facilities.

All individuals/Groups are to clean up after themselves and leave the camp as they found it by departure time.

Pets on a leash are permitted. Owners are responsible for clean-up, feeding and management/control. Animals are not permitted in the Kitchen.

No Alcohol, illegal drugs or personal weapon allowed on camp property.

It is recommended that guests bring their own bedding, pillows, linens, toilet articles, clothing, food and any personal items you may want or need, as these items are <u>NOT</u> supplied and are <u>NOT</u> available for purchase.

US Forest Service fire restrictions will be observed when posted (which could preclude campfires).
