Offering emergency assistance (food, clothing, rent, utilities) for Vanderburgh, Warrick, and Posey County families facing economic challenges, Toy Town (gifts and food for families during the holidays), back to school supplies, coats, and worship/spiritual opportunities.

SALLY'S KITCHEN & FOOD PANTRY

The Salvation Army in Evansville fights food insecurity by serving meals daily to over 200 people Monday-Friday in Sally's Kitchen. Every week, over 120 families receive groceries with the ability to choose the items they need. All made possible by our volunteers, donors, and the annual War on Hunger campaign.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

The Pathway of Hope program mentors families teaching life skills and setting goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. Pathway of Hope aims to move families from crisis to self-sufficiency by equipping them with the tools they need to thrive. There are currently 15 families enrolled.

AFTER SCHOOL YOUTH PROGRAM

With emphasis on academics, athletics, tutoring, arts, and biblical & character development, our after-school programming offers a safe space for K-8 students in our community. The timing and location of our program is critical to keeping our youth safe and investing in the next generation.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Hidden Falls Camp is a 700-acre camp near Bedford. It features nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, high ropes course, archery range and log cabins. Over 600 kids and senior adults from across Indiana participate every summer in various camps (STEAM, music, art, discipleship, age-specific camps), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders on a local, regional and national level. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water and financial assistance at crucial moments.
