

IL Mandated Reporter Training

We are delighted to welcome you as a volunteer to <u>The Salvation Army Metropolitan Division</u>! Volunteers are integral in helping The Salvation Army Do the Most Good locally in greater Chicagoland, Northern Illinois, and Northwest Indiana.

Based on your volunteer position OR location of service, you have been identified as a **Mandated Reporter by the Illinois Department of Child and Family Services (IL DCFS)**. A new law in IL now requires Mandated Reporters to take a special online training course. This does not replace Safe From Harm (SFH) training that is required for standard volunteers by Salvation Army policy. We ask that you complete this training and send verification within 60 days of your start date.

Please follow these directions to complete this process:

- 1- **Complete IL Mandated Reporter training** by creating a log in and following the given instructions at https://mr.dcfstraining.org/UserAuth/Login!loginPage.action.
 - You will need to access a computer to complete all steps. If you do not have a computer, contact your volunteer site to complete in person.
 - Once completed, SAVE your completion certificate as a PDF on computer. To do this, click
 the circle next to "PDF," and then click "View course certificate." (You do not need to click
 "Send course certificate" option.)

- 2- Complete the 2 page IL Mandated Reporter Acknowledgement Form found on the Metro Volunteer Trainings webpage https://centralusa.salvationarmy.org/metro/volunteer-trainings/
 - Choose the PRINT option and PRINT TO PDF via Microsoft Print to PDF or similar application. This will prompt you to SAVE the electronically "printed" document.
 - SAVE it on your computer.
- 3- Notify The Salvation Army of your completion of the IL Mandated Reporter training and upload the 2 PDF documents you have saved at https://sfhreports.wufoo.com/forms/x10v00yq0doivix/.
 - Under "Position(s) within The Salvation Army," select "Volunteer only" unless you additionally are an Employee, Envoy, Retired Officer, or Contract Worker.
 - Under "Division or Command of Salvation Army affiliation" select "Metropolitan Division."
 - Upload the 2 PDF documents you have saved to this form. The Salvation Army Volunteer and Safe From Harm Departments will receive all needed information once you click Submit.
