## HOMELESS SHELTER

The Emergency Lodge is a 45-bed overnight shelter available to individuals and families without the means to provide for their immediate housing. Residents are provided with intensive case management and given the opportunity to set realistic goals and work toward them.

Intake of new residents is available 7 days a week from 4:30pm - 6:30pm.
