MICHIGAN CITY CORPS

Meeting human needs without discrimination through a variety of emergency services, case management, and family-focused programs for Michigan City residents who are facing economic challenges.

WEEKEND BACKPACK PROGRAM

Provides school-aged children in Michigan City Area Schools and Head Start with bagged meals to take home on Fridays during the school year. Made possible through partnership with the Healthcare Foundation of La Porte, Duneland Health Council, and 1st Source Foundation. Serves more than 450 kids with six meals per bag every week.

PATHWAY OF HOPE

Mentors families for 12-18 months with tools for new life skills to set goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, transportation, childcare, and other resources to break generational poverty. Goal: Move from crisis to sufficiency and create brighter futures for children in Michigan City. Bridges Out of Poverty, a short-term case management program, is also offered on a rolling basis.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

Free summer camp for children is provided every year at the 700-acre Hidden Falls Camp near Bedford, Indiana. Features nature trails, an indoor pool, fishing, a challenge course, an archery range, and log cabins. More than 700 children from across the state participate in various five-day camps (STEM, art, music, age-specific) focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

Programs for local families including a food pantry with fresh produce, frozen meat, and non-perishable items; diaper bank providing monthly diapers and wipes for children ages 4 and under; utility assistance to help prevent gas/electric disconnects; and clothing closet with free clothing, shoes, and bedding.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Assisting the community homeless shelter with warm meals; food prescription program in partnership with Franciscan Health; transportation assistance based on verifiable need; worship services and spiritual care; group grief support; monthly free family events including Friday Night @ the Sal and SA Gaming.
