Our Family Shelter works with single women, women with children or an intact family when they need somewhere to turn for assistance.

Since January 2020, we have provided the following services:

- ♥ Assisted 201 individuals
- ♥ Provided nearly 3,900 nights of lodging
- ♥ Provided more than 4,570 meals

While staying at the shelter they are given three meals a day, are given the opportunity to participate in life-skills classes, and work towards finding stability to end the cycle of homelessness.

Shelter residents are encouraged to work with a case worker to find a steady job and their own safe living arrangements facilitated through a program called *Pathway of Hope*.



As part of our program, we also offer homeless prevention services that enable families to remain in a stable housing environment and avoid becoming homeless.

We provide this support through emergency assistance with utilities, rent assistance and food.

In 2020, we have provided assistance to 351 households representing 803 people.

The need has more than doubled since January. From August to September, there was a 33% increase in the number of households who received assistance.
