PORTER COUNTY CORPS

Provides emergency assistance (food, utilities, rent) for Porter County families facing economic challenges. Christmas Toy Shop provides toys, clothing, and food for children. Partnerships provide school supplies. Hosts annual events, including Easter Bunny Breakfast, a local favorite. Weekly worship services and youth, adult, and family programs. Offers music theory, piano, brass, and guitar lessons.

ARCHERY PROGRAM

Serves over 40 kids ranging from ages 7 to 17. Two beginner classes meet weekly on Wednesdays. Intermediate and advanced classes meet Thursdays at the corps. Helps keep youth physically active, builds self-confidence, teaches patience, and focuses on safety protocols.

BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

Pathway of hope mentors families with tools for new life skills and sets goals for housing, employment, budgeting, education, and transportation to break generational poverty. Goal: Move from crisis to sufficiency. The "teach a person to fish" component of our mission.

HIDDEN FALLS CAMP

700-acre camp near Bedford. Nature trails, indoor pool, fishing, challenge course, archery range, and high-quality log cabins. Over 700 kids and senior adults from across Indiana participate every summer in various multi-day camps (STEAM, art, music, age-specific, sports), focusing on the body, mind, and spirit.

EMERGENCY DISASTER SERVICES

Mobilizes officers, employees, volunteers, and mobile food trucks to provide emergency services to victims and first responders. Provides spiritual and emotional counseling, emergency shelter, food, water, and financial assistance at crucial moments.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Resources, referrals, and transportation for people seeking residential addiction treatment services that include counseling and spiritual guidance. Harbor Light Center (Indianapolis) is state certified with the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. Other rehabilitation programs include the Adult Rehabilitation Centers in Fort Wayne and Indianapolis.
