We would encourage you to consider arranging for you and a few others to cover: a Half day which is 10 am to 3 pm or 3 pm to 8 pm...or a full day which is 10 am to 8 pm. This year there are also 3 pm to 6 pm shifts at some locations. If your group arranges to cover a shift, you can arrange to rotate a ringer or two each hour or two hours to cover the scheduled time. 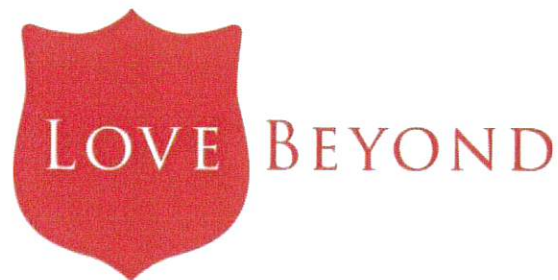

Salvation Army Programs

Food Pantry: The Food Pantry is available to individuals and families within our community once every two weeks. Our goal is to alleviate hunger and provide food to those experiencing food insecurity.

Men's Emergency Shelter: The Men's Emergency Shelter is available to males over the age of 18. Food, shelter, case management, and pastoral care are provided to each shelter guest. Through case management, staff assist clients with identifying barriers and challenges, as well as setting goals towards obtaining permanent housing and a life of self-sufficiency. During the cold months, cold cots are offered through the Emergency Shelter as well. Cold Cots are available to men experiencing homelessness who may not be ready to engage in the shelter program. The goal is to provide warm, safe shelter during the cold months where temperatures can cause harm to those experiencing homelessness.

Pathway of Hope: The Pathway of Hope Program is an approach to providing targeted services to families with a desire to take action to break the cycle of crisis and enable a path out of intergenerational poverty. It is rooted in a case management approach, focusing on client needs through a strength-based lens.

Homeless Prevention: The Homeless Prevention Program is designed to assist individuals and families in need of rent or utility assistance due to hardship to prevent them from becoming homeless. Our goal is to support individuals in maintaining permanent, stable housing.

Prescription Assistance: The Prescription Assistance Program is available to anyone in our community with copayments for their medications. Copayments for medications can be expensive, and our goal is to make sure everyone has access to their prescribed medications by covering medication copayments when needed.

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF): The Decatur Salvation Army Corps partners with SSVF to serve local veterans with case management and housing stability.
