

LPICAMP POSITION SUMMARIES

PROGRAM TEAM:

- **Program Assistant/Assoc. Counselor:** Assists the Program Director in scheduling staff and preparing class/activity resources, assist in planning and presenting evening programs, serves in cabin as assistant to unit counselor. Minimum requisites: Authentic personal Christian faith experience, minimum 18 years of age. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Unit Counselor:** Responsible for the daily supervision of and ministry to youth campers in a residential setting with the assistance of an associate counselor, activity instruction (training provided), assist in recreational supervision. Minimum requisites: Authentic personal Christian faith experience, minimum 18 years of age. One year college or previous experience working with children preferred. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Aquatic Supervisor:** Responsible for the safe operation of all aquatic activities and supervision of aquatic staff. Schedule routine PT & training for guard staff, ensures compliance with ACA Accreditation Standards and MI licensing rules for aquatics. Minimum qualifications: Possess a lifeguard certification and Professional Rescuer CPR from nationally recognized provider within the past 3 years (instructor level preferred), 12 weeks waterfront/guarding experience, 21 years of age. Current or recent WSI and watercraft experience is beneficial. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Waterfront Manager:** Responsible for the daily safe operation of the waterfront, supervise lifeguards and aquatic observers, serves in cabin as assistant to unit counselor. Qualifications: Current lifeguard certification and Professional Rescuer CPR from nationally recognized provider, 18 years of age, six weeks guarding experience. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Watercraft Manager:** Responsible for the safe operation and supervision of all watercraft activities and equipment, serves in cabin as assistant to unit counselor. Qualifications: Current lifeguard certification and Professional Rescuer CPR from nationally recognized provider, 18 years of age, watercraft and six weeks guarding experience. Must be able to obtain small craft license, MI Safe Boaters license or small craft instructor's certification. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Lifeguard:** Assists in the safe operation of all aquatic activities under the direction of the aquatic supervisor and managers. Serve in cabin as assistant to unit counselor if 18+. Qualifications: Current lifeguard certification and Professional Rescuer CPR from nationally recognized provider, minimum 16 years of age. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.

OPERATIONS TEAM:

- **Dining Room Supervisor:** Supervises dining room and serving line operation and food handlers. Minimum 18 years of age. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Food Handler:** Assists in food serving line, dining room facility prep and cleaning. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Kitchen Maintenance:** Cleans dishes/pots and kitchen floors, assists in food stocking. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Cooks' Assistant:** Assists cooks in food preparation, line service and cleaning. Minimum 18 years of age. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Housekeeping/Laundry:** Assist head of housekeeping in cleaning volunteer staff housing, public restrooms and camper/staff laundry. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Grounds & Sanitation:** Assist in minor repairs, sanitation and grounds keeping under the supervision of Facilities Manager. Minimum 18 years of age. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
- **Health Officer's Asst.:** Assists the Health Officer in health services delivery, medication administration and first aid. Minimum qualifications: ARC First Responder and 18 years of age. Position includes weekly seasonal salary, room and board.
