Currently, the Macomb Salvation Army office will have the following changes to its operations:

- The McDonough County Salvation Army office in Macomb will be closed on Tuesday and Thursday until further notice.
- The weight room at the Salvation Army facility is closed until further notice.
- The Salvation Army of Macomb normal food pantry service will be suspended until further notice.
- However, we will make the downstairs "free room" available on Monday,
 Wednesday and Friday during the following times: 11:00 AM to Noon, and from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM.
- We are cleaning the Salvation Army facility twice daily.
- We are prepacking up to 200 bags of food with nonperishable items—for example. a box of cereal, crackers, soup, snacks etc. These bags of food will be available soon when a practical method to distribute them is established.
- We have large vans that we will make available to the community for distributing food and other items as needed.

We thank our communities and supporters for understanding the importance of these changes in order to help mitigate the further spread of this virus.
