

SITE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for helping collect toys and gifts for children in need this Christmas season. We hope to collect toys for over 25,000 children throughout West Michigan and we need your help!

- The Angel Tree toy collection runs from November 1 through the date indicated by your local Salvation Army.
- You will receive your official Angel Tree Toy Drive tags within a few weeks of signing up. Each packet
 has a variety of tags for children of different ages and gender. Please place the tags on your Angel Tree
 for collecting gifts beginning November 1.
- People who want to participate may take one or more tags, purchase an appropriate gift or gift card for
 the child listed on the tag, and return the gift, unwrapped, to your site or any other Angel Tree Toy drive
 site. You are responsible for holding the gift cards that are dropped off in a secure area (envelope in a
 back room, secure drop off box, etc.)
- Your organization is asked to bring collected gifts and gift cards to the designated Salvation Army site in your area. All gifts should be unwrapped and have the Angel Tree Toy Drive tag securely attached when returned. Angel Teen gift cards should be packaged together for drop off in a separate envelope or box labeled "Angel Teen."
- Deliver your gifts and gift cards to the site during the scheduled drop off times (information will be
 provided by your local contact person). Gifts delivered after the last day of collection may be distributed
 for Christmas 2024.
