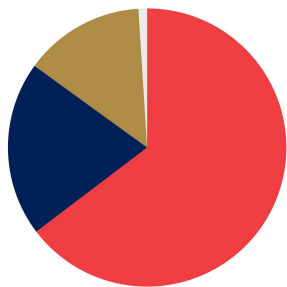

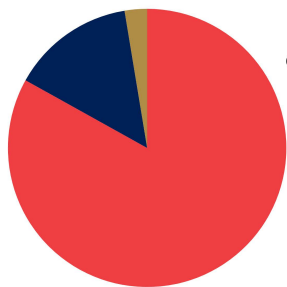


Operating Income \$1,762,972
