Service / Outreach

- West Side Salvation Army serves persons in need in 11 zip codes from Cleves to Delhi (45204, 45205, 45211, 45214, 45233, 45238, 45247, 45248, 45252, 45001, 45002, 45030, 45052)
- Provides Christian Worship Services every Sunday at 10:45am
- Provides a faith-based child care program for children 6 weeks to 12 years of age from 6:15am to 6:00pm
- Provides rent and utility assistance, food, clothing, furniture, bus tokens, identification and referral services to persons in need as funding is available.
- Sends children and teens to summer camp at Camp SWONEKY
- Provides Christmas food vouchers to individuals and families, and gifts to their children
- Visits hospitals and nursing homes in offering hope and encouragement at Christmas and Easter
- Provides fellowship groups for women and men, and evening programs for teens and children through the Salvation Army church



2014 Statistics

- 14,204 meals were fed to low income children in the Learning Center Child Care day care and school age programs
- 1547 persons received food, 2481 persons received emergency assistance, 949 persons received transportation assistance, and 171 received other assistance
- 65 children were provided snacks and activities during our church programs though out the year.
- 14 children enjoyed a summer week-long camp experience at Camp SWONEKY costing them only \$10 (a \$500 value)
- 712 families received food vouchers (2,545 individuals) for their Christmas dinner
- 1,524 children received Christmas gifts
- 1,343 persons were visited in care facilities offering them a warm blanket and a word of encouragement
