As a Salvation Army volunteer, you agree to:

- Stay home if you are not feeling well.
- Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- Submit to a temperature check upon arrival.
- Wear a face mask at all times. The face mask must cover your <u>nose</u>, <u>mouth</u> and <u>chin</u>; no exceptions.
- Maintain 6 feet social distancing at all times.
- Wash hands often and/or use of hand sanitizer. Note: Hand sanitizer and restrooms will be accessible.
- Refrain from eating and drinking while on duty as this requires the removal of a face mask. Please plan to eat before you arrive or after you leave.
- Follow all directions provided to you by the Salvation Army officer or employee in charge.
