THE DOCTRINES of the Salvation Army

WE BELIEVE that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments were given by inspiration of God, and that they only constitute the Divine rule of Christian faith and practice.

WE BELIEVE that there is only one God, who is infinitely perfect, the Creator, Preserver, and Governor of all things, and who is the only proper object of religious worship.

WE BELIEVE that repentance towards God, faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, and regeneration by the Holy Spirit, are necessary to salvation.

WE BELIEVE that we are justified by grace through faith in our Lord Jesus Christ and that he that believeth hath the witness in himself.

WE BELIEVE that continuance in a state of salvation depends upon continued obedient faith in Christ.

WE BELIEVE that it is the privilege of all believers to be wholly sanctified, and that their whole spirit and soul and body may be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

WE BELIEVE in the immortality of the soul; in the resurrection of the body; in the general judgment at the end of the world; in the eternal happiness of the righteous; and in the endless punishment of the wicked.

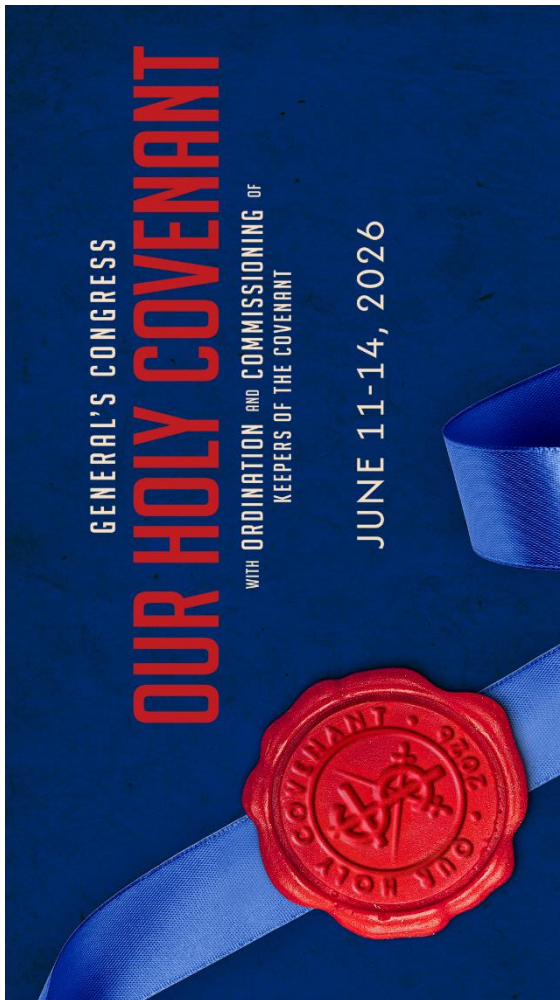

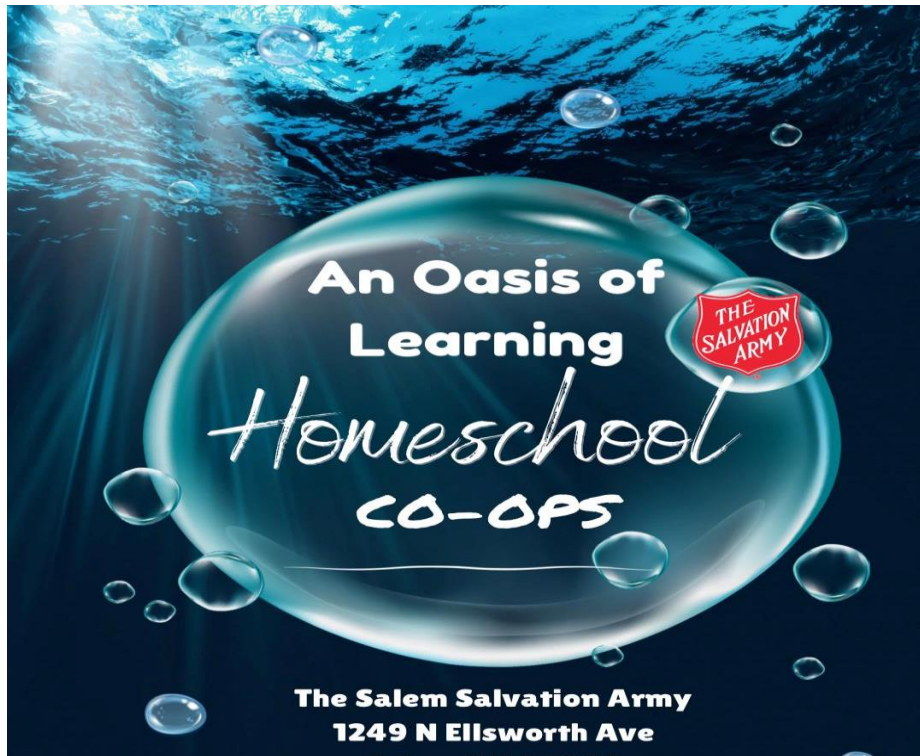

Thank you for choosing Camp NEOSA for one of your child's adventures this summer! We are excited to be able to help them enjoy the great outdoors this summer! This information is for The Salem Salvation Army location only. If you live outside of our area and would like information on going to Camp with your local Salvation Army please call our office and we can make that connection.

- Registration to secure your child's space at camp will take place online this year. You will want to go to the website:

Click on Camper Application at the top.

It will then prompt you to put personal information in.

When asking for location our location is in the drop down menu please pick Salem

-After completing the online portion of the application there will be a spot where you can download the medical forms and food service forms, The forms will need to be and have a wet signatures on them to go to camp still. Any medication your child will be taking to camp needs to be listed on the medical form with the correct dosages. All medication must come in original bottles. We will also need to make a photo copy of your child's health insurance card prior to leaving. We have to have all information back to camp three weeks before they leave for camp this year. These forms will be uploaded into the computer but hard copies will also need to be dropped off at our office.

- Cost will be \$25 per child. This payment can be made by cash or check anytime prior to leaving for camp. This is the cost per week chosen.

- As we get closer to camp session starts we will be letting you know when pick up's will be for the last day of the camp session. Luggage & medicine must be dropped off the day before the camp session starts between 5pm-6pm. The morning of the camp session we will leave at 7:15am from The Salem Salvation Army

- If you have any questions, need us to print forms for you, or have trouble entering the information in online we would be happy to help!

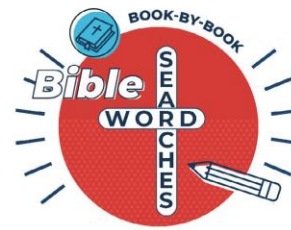

OVERVIEW

Matthew was writing to Jews who were well-studied, which is why his gospel often quotes the Old Testament to show how prophecy was fulfilled. It is a great gospel for apologetics, a.k.a. defense of our faith due to all the "proofs."

The book contains a genealogy that dates back to Abraham. It differs from a genealogy in early Luke. Scholars say one is a list of legal parentage and the other is a bloodline.
