The Salvation Army's service has often been described as a "Ministry of Presence".

The Salvation Army has 28 corps community centers throughout the State of New Jersey as well as a 400 acre residential camp in Hunterdon County offering various services and programs, one of which is the Emergency Disaster Services program which is based in the State Headquarters in Union, NJ.

During times of disaster, The Salvation Army is prepared to offer:

- On-site assistance to disaster workers and emergency management personnel
- Emotional and Spiritual Ministry
- Mass and Individual Feeding - Lead Agency in the State's EFS6 Feeding Plan
- Case Management
- Emergency Shelters
- Comfort Stations
- Distribution of clothing, food, relief supplies, and any other necessary items.
- Translation Services
- Donations Management
- A national network of volunteers and equipment
- Collaboration with other disaster relief agencies, NJVOAD, and recovery organizations
- Volunteer Management and Trainings
