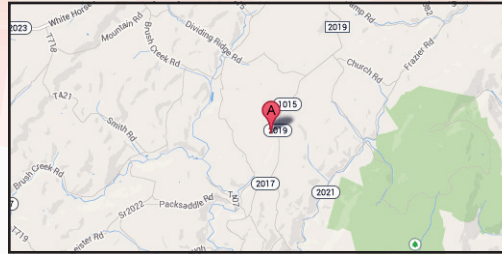

Directions to the ICC from West

Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike - 76 - East
Get off the turnpike at the Somerset Exit #110
Follow signs for 31 East by going to fourth light and turn left onto 31 East
Go approximately 13 miles & turn right onto Dividing Ridge Rd. *(There is a large dairy farm on right at bottom of steep hill at this road.)*
Follow Dividing Ridge until it dead ends into Glen Savage Road
Turn right onto Glen Savage Road.
The ICC is on the right about a mile up the road. Front entrance has a nine foot fenced property.
