Paul Gascon Scholarship

USJE Fall 2019 to Summer 2020 Scholarship Program

Program Guidelines

This scholarship is of \$2,500.00 and is for USJE Members only. The USJE Member applying must be in good standing as of February 1st of the year in which the scholarship is to be awarded.

The scholarship is not restricted to first-year students. The Member may attend school on a part-time or full-time basis and be in any field of study. The Member may attend a College, University, Trade School as long as it is an accredited education learning facility. **No applicant will be awarded a scholarship more than once.**

The scholarship is awarded primarily based on the merit of the 800-word essay according to the essay topic determined for the given year.

The application will be reviewed as a whole; however the USJE Scholarship Committee will place most emphasis upon the submitted essay.

Applicant Requirements

- Completed application form with all relevant information;
- An 800-word essay on the topic chosen by the USJE for the current year.
- USJE 2019/2020 Scholarship(s) Essay Question:

If you were elected leader of a well-established union in Canada, what would be your 3 top priorities, and how would you implement them?

- Proof of registration with the name of the university, college or institute of higher learning. Attendance will be verified before granting of the award(s). Recipients must attend school during the academic year (Fall 2019 to Summer 2020) or it will default to another applicant.
- A transcript of most current academic standing (if applicable).
- Recipients will be asked to provide their Social Insurance Number (S.I.N.) in order to receive the scholarship.



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The USJE reserves the right to withhold the granting of an award if no applicant is deemed to possess the necessary requirements, or for other valid reasons. **All submissions become the property of the USJE.**

All documents sent by mail must be received or postmarked no later than February 1, 2019. Documents sent by email or fax must be received by the USJE by 4:00 p.m. EST. Confirmation of complete applications will be provided by the USJE.
