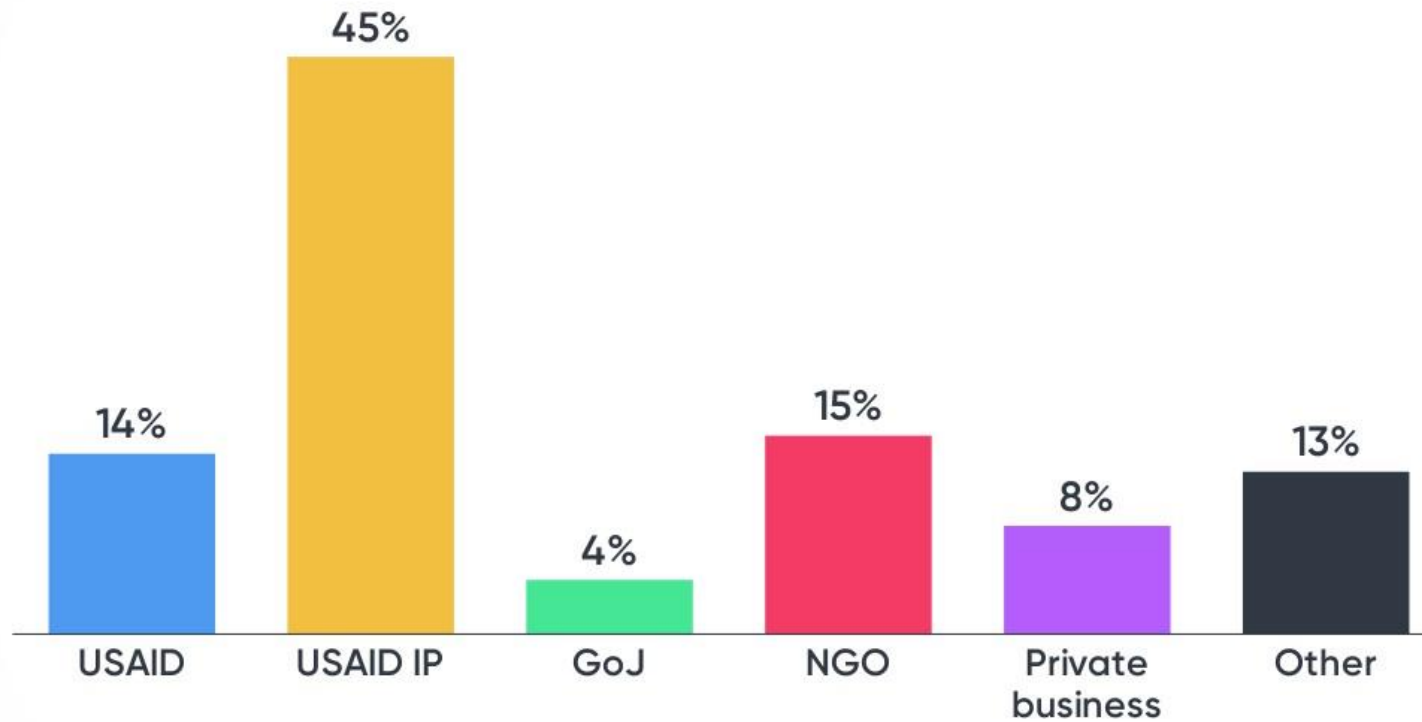

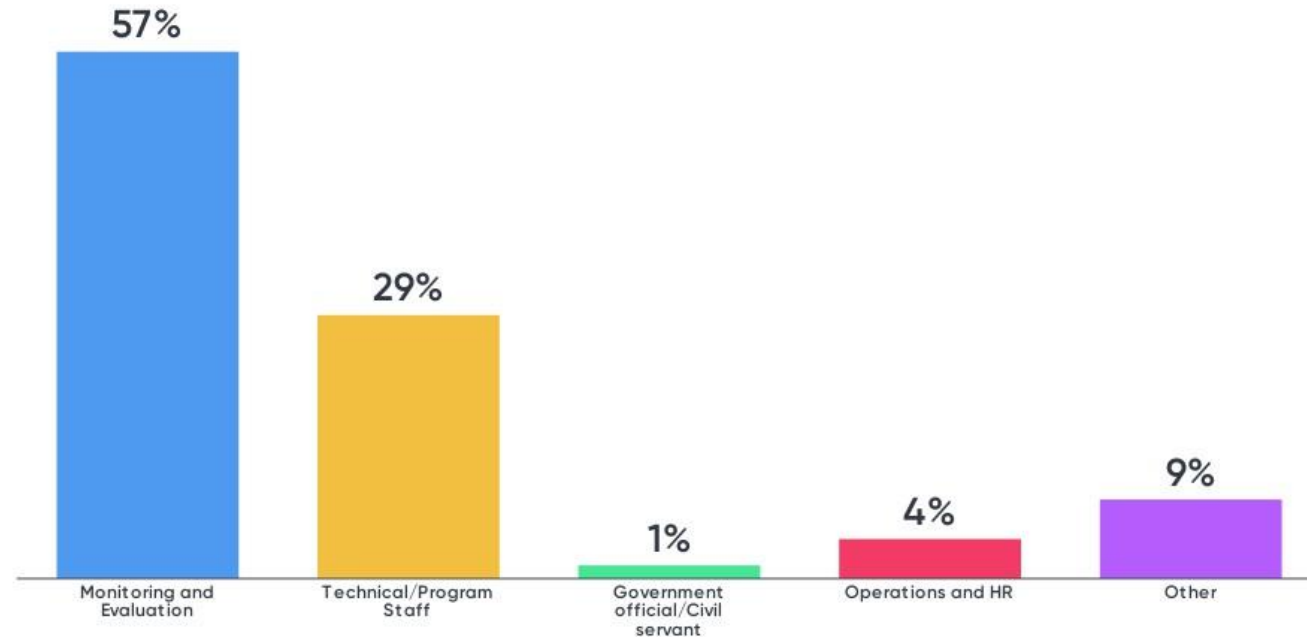

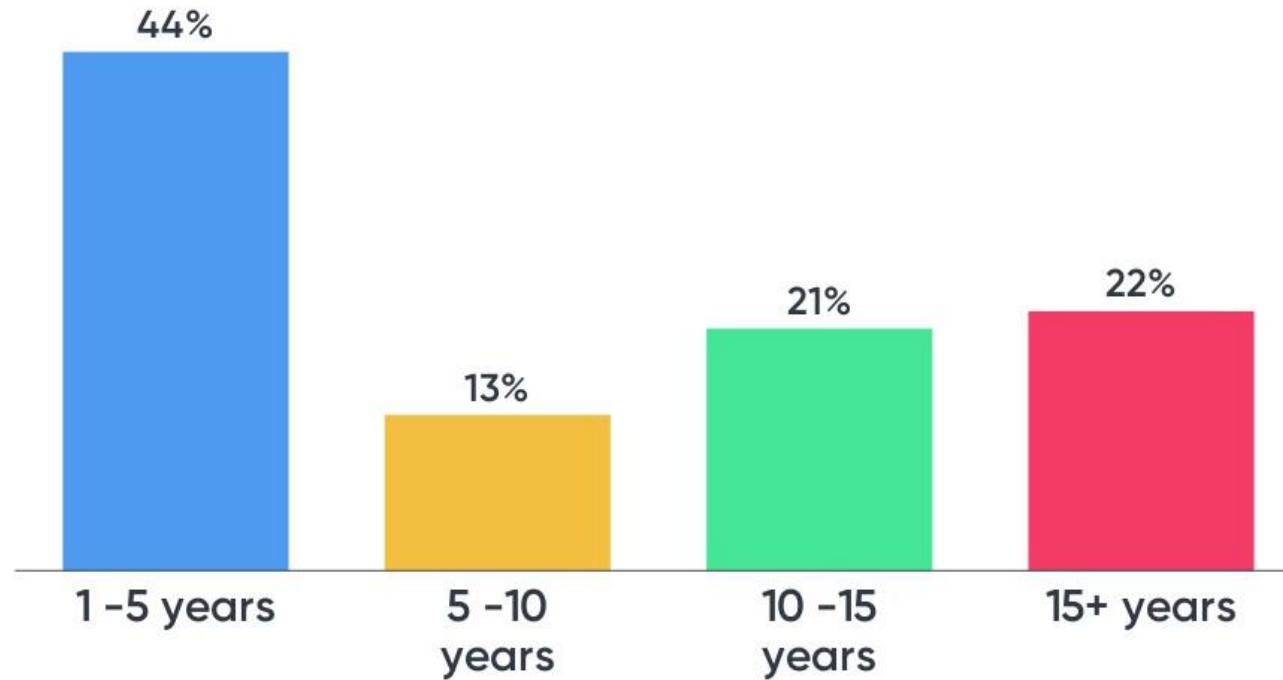

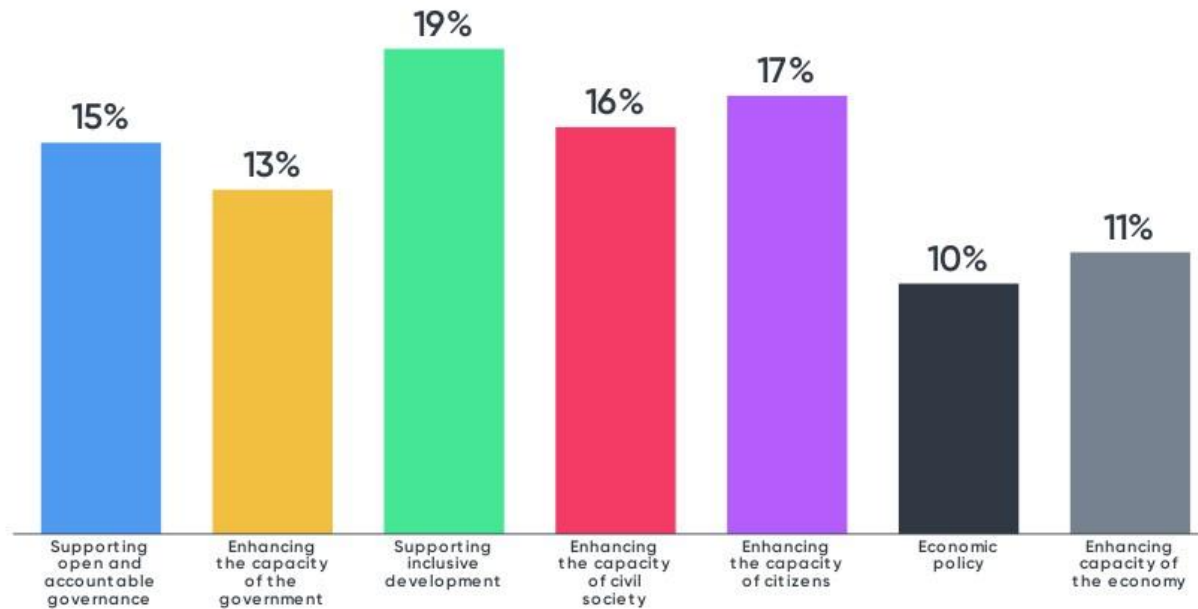

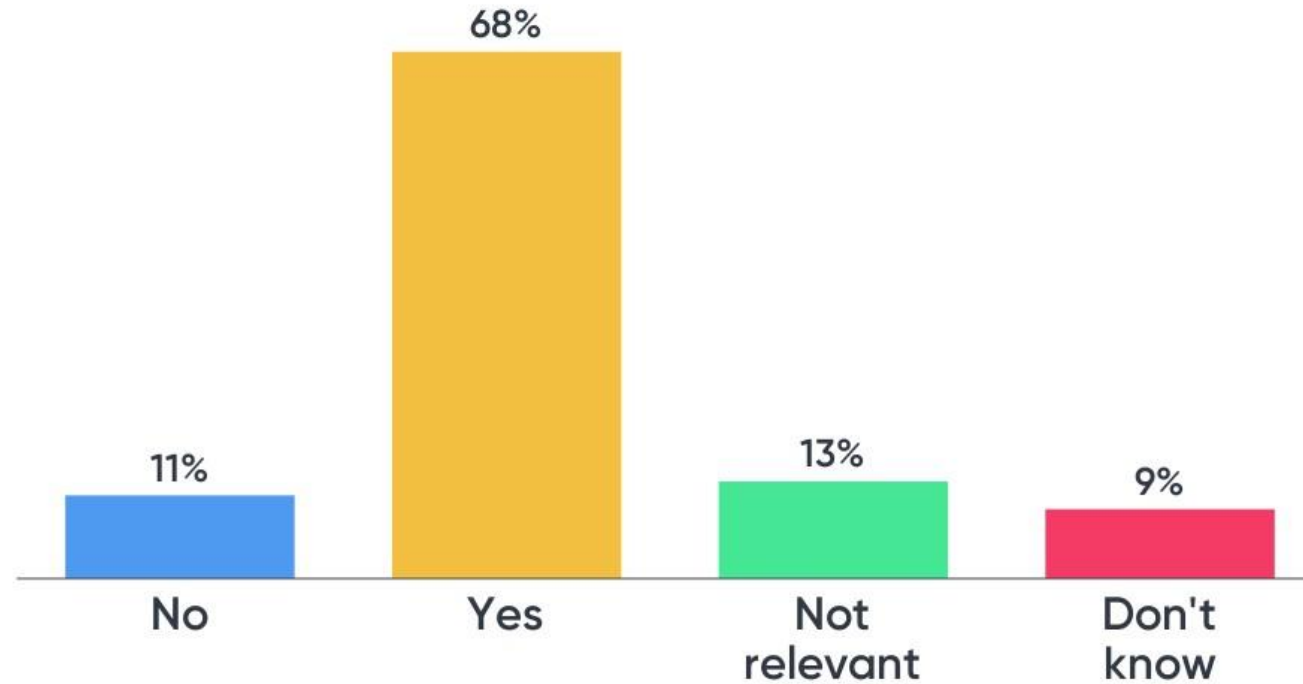

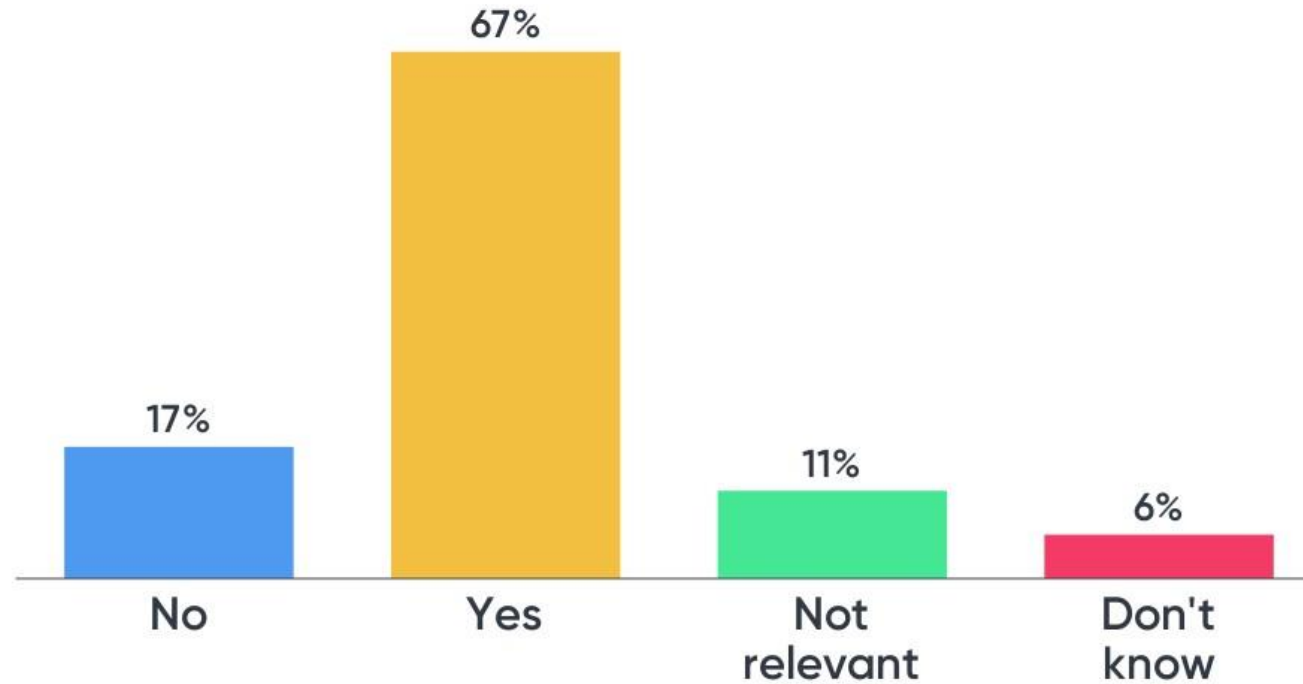

How familiar are you with the concept of sustainability?



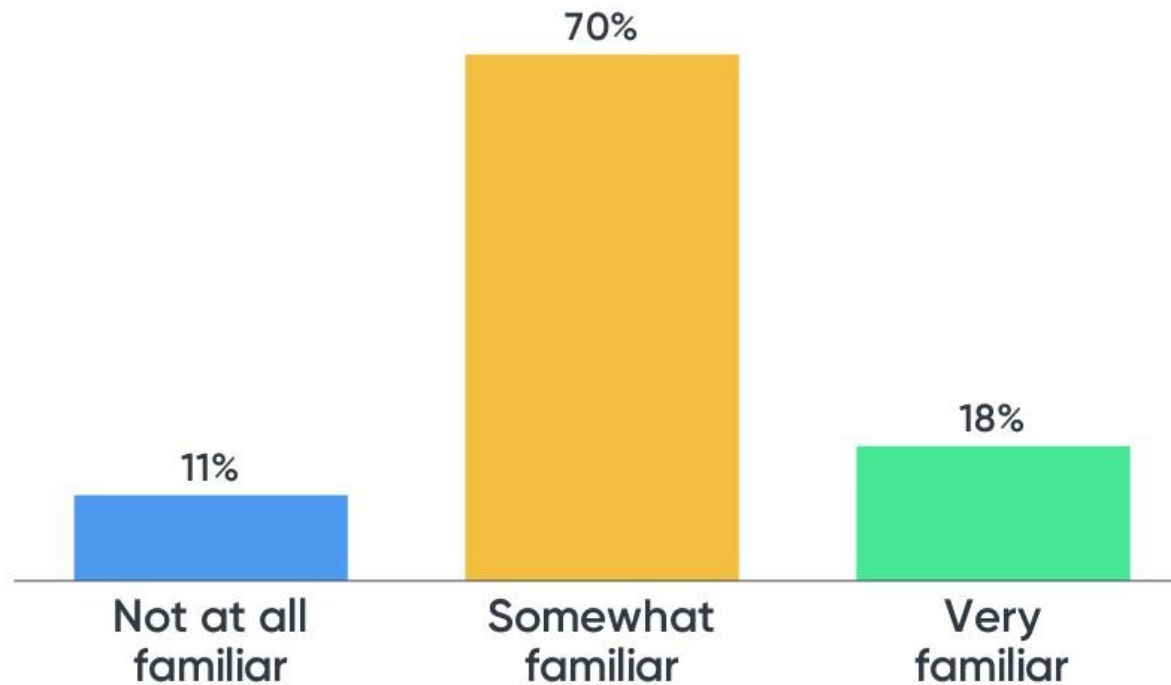

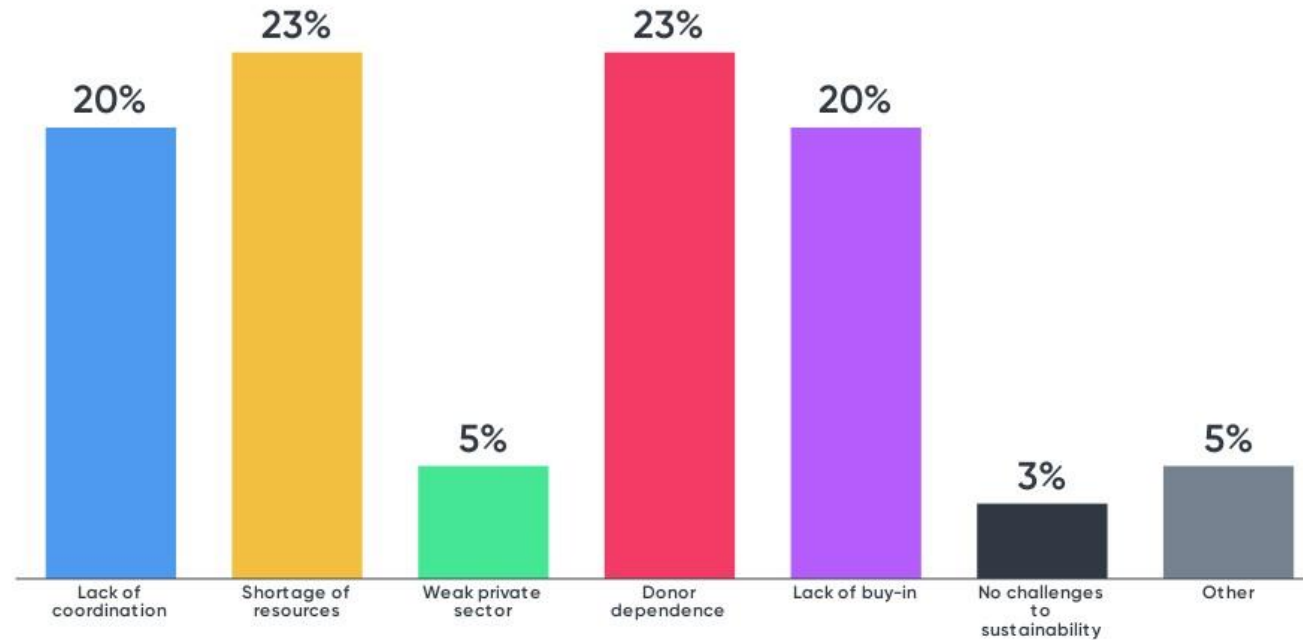

USAID new strategic direction and GPS activity will support sustaining the communication programs at the levels of MOH and Civil Society

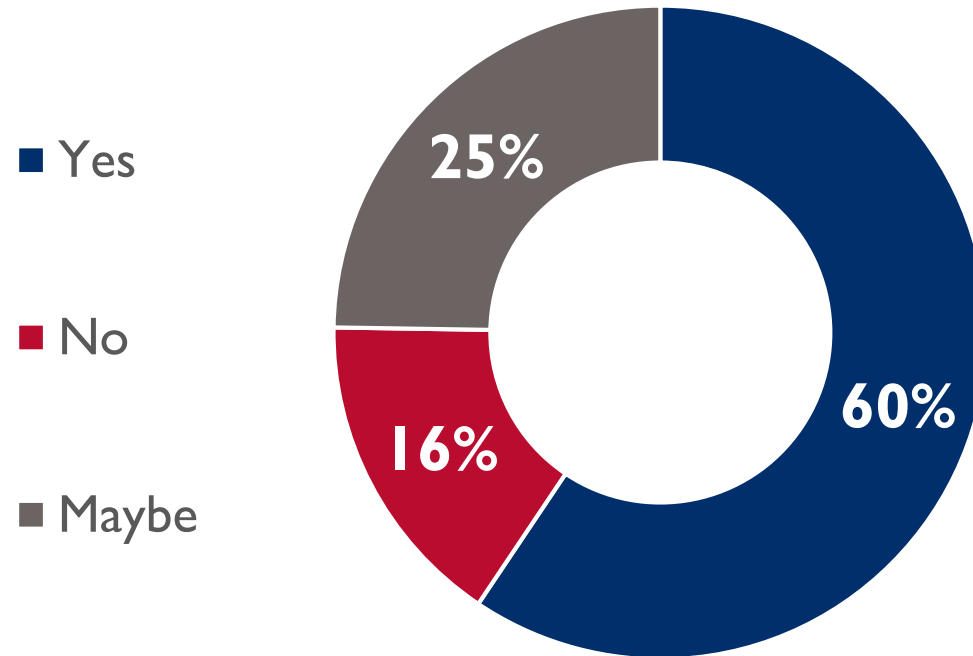
