

UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY SEEKS ACADEMY PROFESSOR DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY AND LIFE SCIENCE

The United States Military Academy is accepting applications for an Academy Professor position in the disciplines of Life Science, Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, Bioengineering, or a closely related field. Principal responsibilities include academic leadership, teaching, and research. Specific duties will include teaching undergraduate courses in chemistry, life science, chemical engineering, and/or bioengineering; supervision of faculty and academic programs; curriculum development; faculty development; service on faculty committees; and research. Applicants should have a demonstrated capacity for further academic achievement and scholarship. Dedication to excellence in teaching is an absolute requirement. Candidates must hold a Ph.D. in a relevant field or hold an M.S. degree and be able to obtain a Ph.D. within three years of study. Applicants must have a strong commitment to the educational, military, physical, and ethical development of cadets. Applicants should possess an exemplary military record including significant leadership experience, experience in operational units, and advanced military schooling (Intermediate Level Education as a minimum). The selection committee will evaluate breadth and depth of military experience, academic achievement, scholarly potential, and evidence of leadership and vision. The minimum rank to apply is major.
