

UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY SEEKS ACADEMY PROFESSOR DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH AND WORLD LANGUAGES

The United States Military Academy (USMA) is accepting applications for the position of Academy Professor in the Department of English and World Languages (DEWL). Principal responsibilities of the position include academic leadership, teaching, and scholarship in either the French or German language and Area Studies Programs. Specific duties will include faculty development, curriculum development, teaching undergraduate courses, institutional governance, and research. The candidate selected for this position should have previous professional teaching experience, preferably in French or German language, linguistics, literature, or area studies at the college/university level. Candidates are expected to have the potential to draw from a broad humanities-based focus on the French or German language and related cultures to inform multidisciplinary regional analysis. The ability to teach and conduct research in more than one of the department's eight foreign languages (Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Persian, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish) is preferred. Candidates must possess or demonstrate the potential to reach a distinguished level of French or German written and spoken proficiency. Candidates should hold a Ph.D. degree in languages, literature, linguistics, area studies (or a closely related discipline) or hold a related master's degree and be able to obtain a Ph.D. within three years of study. Demonstrated ability to mentor cadets in projects that apply linguistic and cultural knowledge within an interdisciplinary setting to social, political, and international problem sets is highly desirable. Candidates should possess an exemplary military record including significant leadership experience, experience in operational units, advanced military schooling (Intermediate Level Education as a minimum), with field experience in areas related to the subjects taught by the Department preferred. The minimum rank to apply is major.
