

UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY SEEKS PROFESSOR, USMA, AND DEPUTY HEAD, DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING

The United States Military Academy (USMA) is accepting applications for the position of Professor, USMA, and Deputy Head in the Department of Geography and Environmental Engineering. The officer selected will serve as principal assistant to the Department Head in overseeing the planning, resourcing, implementation, and assessment of undergraduate education in core and elective courses in geography, environmental science, and geospatial information science. The Deputy Head will be responsible for academic administration, personnel and resource management, faculty development, and teaching and mentoring cadets. Additionally, the Deputy Head will serve in USMA governance activities and coordinate with outside agencies. Applicants should possess a Ph.D. in geography, environmental science, geospatial information science, or a closely related discipline, with extensive college or professional teaching experience preferred. Applicants should possess an exemplary military record including significant leadership experience, experience in operational units, and advanced military schooling (Intermediate Level Education as a minimum). Applicants should demonstrate a high capacity for excellence in teaching, scholarship, faculty development, and service. Applicants must have a strong commitment to the educational, military, physical and ethical development of cadets. The selection committee will evaluate breadth and depth of military experience, academic achievement, scholarly potential, and evidence of leadership and vision. The officer selected for this position may serve at the discretion of the Secretary of the Army until age 64. The minimum rank to apply is lieutenant colonel.
