The United States Military Academy is accepting applications for Academy Professor positions in political science and the Combating Terrorism Center. Applicants should have a demonstrated capacity for academic achievement and scholarship. Principal responsibilities of the positions include academic leadership, teaching, scholarship, and administration. Specific duties include teaching undergraduate courses in American politics, public policy, terrorism studies, and/or international affairs; supervising the development and execution of academic programs; developing faculty; leading cadet development activities; contributing to institutional governance; and conducting research. Dedication to excellence in teaching is an absolute requirement; candidates should have previous college-level or professional teaching experience. In addition, they must hold a Ph.D. in political science, public policy, or economics, or hold an M.A., M.P.A., or M.P.P. degree and be able to obtain a Ph.D. within three years of study. Applicants must have a strong commitment to the intellectual, military, physical, and ethical development of cadets. Candidates should possess an exemplary military record including significant leadership experience, completion of advanced military schooling (Intermediate Level Education as a minimum), field experience in areas related to the subjects taught by the Department, and recent experience in operational units. The selection committee will evaluate breadth and depth of military experience, academic achievement, scholarly potential, and evidence of leadership and vision. The minimum rank to apply is major.
