

The Salvation Army Boys & Girls Clubs of Metro Tulsa MEMBERSHIP DUES & PROGRAM FEES

ENROLLMENT FEE: Parents/Guardians are required to pay an annual Membership Fee of \$40.00 per child to The Boys & Girls Club. This annual payment entitles your child to participate in other club programs throughout the year, including Afterschool Program, School Break Camps, and Summer Programs. Enrollment Fee will be due, on or before, the first day of your child's attendance. Your child's participation in our program is not guaranteed until enrollment fee has been paid.

WEEKLY RATES: Weekly Rates vary from Club to Cub. Weekly Fees must be prepaid or paid on the first day of the week. (Typically, Mondays). It is important to keep payments up to date to avoid disruption of program participation.

For your convenience, payment can be accepted by check, cash, or debit/credit card. We currently do not offer online payment, but you may pay by phone by contacting your local Club. (*Online Payment options are coming soon.*)

ATHLETIC/SPORTS FEES: Each individual athletic/sports program offered requires an additional participation fee. We aim to make these programs affordable for families and where practical, athletic equipment/uniforms can be provided.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Our aim is to ensure that membership dues and program fees are not a barrier to kids being able to access our programs. Financial Assistance is available. To apply, contact your Club's Unit Director for an Application. Requests for Financial Assistance are submitted to our Administrative Office for consideration/approval and are not handled at the local Club level. Applications with missing or incomplete information, will not be considered.

LATE PICKUP FEES: \$1.00 per minute will be charged PER CHILD if a child/children are picked up after close of operating hours, typically 6:06 pm. Phone calls to notify of late pickup will not exempt a late fee charge. Accounts will be billed.

RETURNED CHECK FEES: There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all returned checks.

REFUNDS: We have a no refund policy regarding membership dues, program, and athletic programs. Should this need arise, you are encouraged to contact your Club's Unit Director to discuss how funds already paid can be applied to future services. Club Directors do not have authorization to issue refund payments.

Our Boys & Girls Clubs is committed to providing you and your children with a first-class program. Our aim is to provide an atmosphere that is safe, fun, and positive. The program is a learning/growing program that provides the kind of structure kids need today. It is important for you to communicate with your Unit Director on these matters, to avoid any interruption in this experience.
