HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

The Salvation Army's Silver Bell program provides Christmas assistance for seniors ages 62 and older who are experiencing a financial hardship. Recipients must meet and verify low-income status to be eligible for assistance during an in-person appointment.

You will need to bring a photo ID and one of the following verification items:

- TANF case statement
- SNAP letter
- Social Security letter
- Bank statement showing direct deposit for SSI, SSD, etc.
- Letter from employer stating income
