What is PIT?

The **Point-in-Time (PIT)** count provides a one-night snapshot of homelessness in our region, including those in shelters, transitional housing, domestic violence shelters, or unsheltered locations.

Homelessness takes many forms, all reflecting broader crises of economic inequality and housing affordability. The Greater Richmond Continuum of Care (GRCoC) unites community-based agencies* to **focus on supporting those without a stable place to live.**

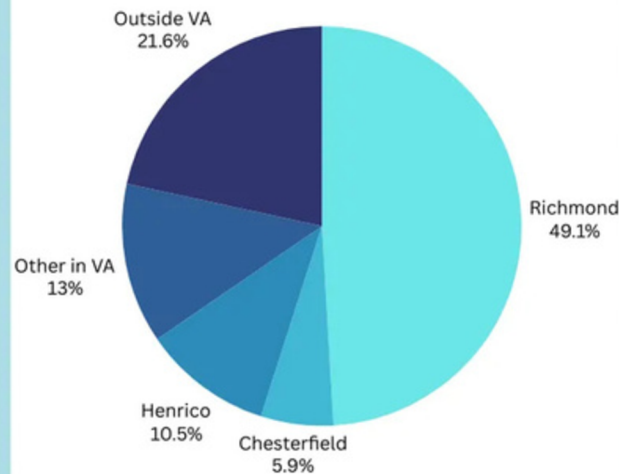
