CHARLOTTE, N.C. (July 23, 2025) – The Salvation Army of Greater Charlotte has received \$3,600 from the Food Lion Feeds Charitable Foundation to help nourish neighbors experiencing hunger. The "Nourishing Our Neighbors" grant supports community feeding partners as they tackle food insecurity and promote healthier lifestyles through nutritional education initiatives.
