Go Dawgs! My godmother Jackie's Cheesecake is a light and delicious variation of a traditional cheesecake that is always a hit and reminds me of her every time I make it.

I can't wait for the luncheon in April and am excited to share my favorite recipes to help the Salvation Army with their mission in Jacksonville.

Recipe Corner

Aunt Libby's Hamburger Soup

1 lb lean ground beef	1 lg. chopped onion
1 (16 oz) can of cream style corn	1 (10 oz) can Rotel diced tomatoes
1 (16 oz) can of stewed tomatoes	1 (11 oz) can of V8 juice
1 (15 oz) box of Spanish rice (or cooked Spanish rice)	
1 can diced tomatoes for Spanish rice	

Brown ground beef and onion together. Add rest of ingredients. Simmer on low for 30-40 minutes. Hearty meal we always serve after GA-FL game. Especially good with spinach cornbread recipe also submitted.

Aunt Libby's Spinach Cornbread

1 box Jiffy corn muffin mix	1 onion, chopped
6 oz. cottage cheese	1 stick margarine, melted
½ teaspoon salt	6 eggs, beaten
1 pkg. chopped spinach, thawed and drained	

Grease 10" pyrex dish. Bake at 400 degrees for 30 minutes. Delicious cornbread everyone loves, especially served with butter. Perfectly compliments my hamburger soup recipe.

Jackie's Cheesecake

1 graham cracker pie crust

Cheesecake:

2 lg. (16 oz) cream cheese
½ cup sugar
2 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla

Icing:

1 cup sour cream
5 Tablespoons sugar
½ teaspoon vanilla

Cheesecake:

Soften cream cheese, blend with sugar. Add beaten eggs and vanilla. Beat with mixer until creamy smooth. Pour into pie crust. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Remove from oven and let cool for a few minutes.

Icing: Mix ingredients. Pour over cake spreading smoothly. Return cake to oven at 350 degrees to cook for another 10 minutes. Refrigerate at least 5 hours. A family favorite that's a delicious but different cheesecake.


