CHRISTMAS ASSISTANCE INFO

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

The Salvation Army's Angel Tree program provides Christmas assistance for children who are age 13 years or younger as of 12/25/2025 and are in families experiencing a financial hardship. Parents and/or legal guardians of the children receiving gifts must meet and be able to verify low-income status to be eligible for assistance during an in-person appointment.



ENROLLMENT DETAILS



APPLY online September 23-25

- You will need an email address to apply. One email per family application.
- Registration access opens daily at 9 a.m. and closes once spots are filled.
- Once you submit your application, you will receive an email with a date and time for your in-person appointment during October 7-10.



INTERVIEW at Christmas Center October 7-10

- Come to the Christmas Center (9204 Stony Point Parkway) on your assigned date and time to verify income eligibility, children's birth certificates and finalize your wishlist.
- You must attend your appointment to be fully enrolled and receive assistance.
- You will receive a date and time to return to the Christmas Center for gift pick-up.



BRING documents to verify eligibility

REQUIRED

1. Income verification (paystubs, child support, etc)
2. Proof of residency with current address (utility bill, rental agreement, etc)
3. Birth certificates (original) or passport for all angels

OPTIONAL

- TANF, SNAP or WIC award letter
- Child/children's Medicaid card
