Electronic Usage Agreement (Bring Your Own Device Policy)

The Salvation Army Boys & Girls Clubs of Greensboro has adopted a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) policy for its clubs.





<u>Club purposes</u> include program activities, career development, communication with experts and/or Club peer members, homework and Club activities. Members are expected to act responsibly and thoughtfully when using technology resources. Members bear the burden of responsibility to inquire with staff when they are unsure of the permissibility of a particular use of technology prior to engaging in the use.

Personally owned devices are permitted for use during Club time for Club purposes and in approved locations only. The Club expressly prohibits use of personally owned devices in locker rooms and restrooms and other areas where there is an expectation of privacy.

Any inappropriate use of a personally owned device, as determined by Club staff, can lead to disciplinary action including, but not limited to, confiscation of the device, immediate suspension from the Club, termination of membership, or other disciplinary actions determined to be appropriate to the Club's existing disciplinary policies including, if applicable, referral to local law enforcement.

<u>Inappropriate communication</u> includes, but is not limited to, the following: obscene, profane, lewd, vulgar, rude, inflammatory, threatening, or disrespectful language or images typed, posted, or spoken by members; information that could cause damage to an individual or the Club community or create the danger of disruption of the Club environment; personal attacks, including prejudicial or discriminatory attacks; harassment (persistently acting in a manner that distresses or annoys another person) or stalking of others; knowingly or recklessly posting false or defamatory information about a person or organization; and communication that promotes the destruction of property, including the acquisition or creation of weapons or other destructive devices. If a member is told to stop sending communications, that member must cease the activity immediately.

Members may not utilize any technology to harass, threaten, demean, humiliate, intimidate, embarrass, or annoy their peers or others in their community. This behavior is cyberbullying, bullying that takes place using emerging technologies and devices. Examples of cyberbullying include mean text messages or emails, rumors sent by email or posted on social networking sites, and embarrassing pictures, videos, websites, or fake profiles. Any cyber bullying that is determined to disrupt the safety and/or well-being of the Club, Club Member, Club Staff or community is subject to disciplinary action.

Monitoring and inspection. Salvation Army Boys & Girls Clubs of Greensboro of Greensboro reserves the right to monitor, inspect, copy, and review a personally owned device that is brought to the Club. Parents/Guardians will be notified before such an inspection takes place and may be present, at their choice, during the inspection. Parents/Guardians may refuse to allow such inspections but the member may be barred from bringing personally owned devices to the Club in the future.

<u>Loss and Damage.</u> Members are responsible for keeping the device with them at all times. Staff are not responsible for the security and condition of the member's personal device. Furthermore, The Club shall not be liable for the loss, damage, misuse, theft of any personally owned device brought to Club.

<u>Parental Notification and Responsibility.</u> BGCA's Internet Acceptable Use Policy restricts the access of inappropriate material and while using the internet supervision of usage may not always be possible. Due to the wide range material available on the internet, some material may not fit the particular values of members and their families. Because of this, it is not practical for BGCA to monitor and enforce a wide range of social values in student use of the Internet. If parents do not want members to access information beyond the scope of the Internet Acceptable Use Policy, parents should instruct members not to access such materials.





Electronic Usage Agreement (Bring Your Own Device Policy) CONTINUED

- In order to utilize the Salvation Army Boys & Girls Clubs of Greensboro BYOD services (including the wireless network), members and parents must review and sign the Acceptable Use Policy. This is considered a legally binding agreement.
- 2. The member will take full responsibility for his or her device and keeps it with himself or herself at all times. Members may not lend their device to any other Club member or staff. The Club is not responsible for the security of the device or loss/damage/theft of a personally owned device.
- 3. The member is responsible for the proper care of their personal device, including any costs of repair, replacement or any modifications needed to use the device at the Club.
- 4. Members should only use their device to access services, networks, files relevant to Club sanctioned programs. Members should only use the features of their device, including (but not limited to) taking or transmitting pictures, video, location information or other features in accordance with Program offerings.
- 5. Members may not use the devices to record, transmit or post pictures, video or other information of or about a person or persons at the Club. Nor can any images, video or other information recorded at the Club be transmitted or posted at any time without the express permission of Club Staff.
- 6. Members must use the Club's secured wireless network. Use of cellular (e.g. 3G, 4G) cellular wireless connections is not allowed.
- 7. The Club reserves the right to inspect a member's personal device. Parents/Guardians will be notified and allowed to be present before any such inspection takes place. Parents/Guardians are free to refuse to allow Club staff to inspect a device; however, that member may be barred from bringing personally-owned devices to the Club in the future. This decision will be at the Club's discretion.
- 8. Members must comply with staff requests to shut down or turn off the device when asked. Failure to do so may result in the member being barred from bringing personal devices in the future.
- 9. Violations of any Club policies, administrative procedures or Club rules involving a member's personally owned device may result in the loss of use of the device at the Club and/or disciplinary action.

- 2. **Participate** Club members will be required to participate in new opportunities at the club. We will work to expose members to a variety of opportunities that require an open mind.
- 3. <u>Listen</u> Club members will be required to listen and follow directions of club staff and volunteers throughout the club day.
- 4. <u>Hands OFF</u> Club members are required to keep their hands off at all times. Horseplay, wrestling, and fighting are not permitted at the Club.
- 5. <u>Have FUN!!!</u> When all of these rules are followed, our members will have fun!

All club members are expected to know and follow these club rules. Please see the following club discipline procedures:

- Positive Redirection and Recognition: Club staff use positive reinforcement and direction to create a positive environment.
- Staff members will create consequences when necessary to help youth learn rules and understand expectations.

ALL field trips and special events are a privilege. Club members can and will lose their privilege to participate if they do not follow the club rules or are written up.

- If club consequences are ineffective, a club member will be written up. The club director will
 decide if a write up is a "STRIKE". If a club member reaches three "STRIKES", they maybe
 suspended for three days from the Salvation Army Boys & Girls Clubs of Greensboro. After two
 club suspensions, the club direction may remove the youth from our club program for the
 remainder of the season.
- Fighting, bullying, leaving the club without permission, or extreme behavior may result in immediate progressive discipline.
- All discipline concerns must be communicated to the Unit Director. Please understand that the unit director will be available to address discipline concerns only during their working hours.
