



2014 US Open Main Draw Wild Card

WOMEN'S FACT SHEET

Details:	The USTA will be awarding one (1) women's main draw wild card to the 2014 US Open based on performance in a series of USTA Pro Circuit events. The wild card will be awarded to the American player with the highest total of cumulative main draw WTA ranking points from the events listed below: • Players' best two (2) results from the three events will be used and combined to calculate the point total. • In the event of a tie, the player with the best WTA ranking in the published WTA rankings of Monday, July 28, 2014 will be awarded the wild card. • Players must compete in at least one of the three events listed below to be considered for the wild card. • Should the player with the highest total of cumulative singles WTA points become a Direct Acceptance into the US Open, the next qualified American player with the highest cumulative total of singles WTA points will be awarded the wild card (ties will be broken as described above). • In the event that issues arise that are not covered by these rules, USTA Player Development will be the final arbiter.		
Eligibility:	• Players who are USA passport holders and are eligible to represent the United States in Fed Cup competition in 2014 are eligible to be considered for the main draw wild card. • The minimum age for eligibility is 14. There is no maximum age restriction.
