- Entry Fees:** Juniors: Singles \$15.00; Doubles (per team) \$20.00  
Adults: Singles \$20.00; Doubles (per team) \$30.00
- Awards:** Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and Consolation in draw events and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in round robins.
- Participation Limit:** 1 Singles and 1 Doubles event or 1 Doubles (A,B,C) and 1 Doubles (Social, Competitive Mixed or 60 and Over)
- Age Requirement:** Since this is not a USTA event, juniors may enter the age division in which he or she falls as of June 9.  
Players in the adult division must be out of high school.
- Seeding Information:** Please provide information such as USTA ranking and tournament results to help us with seeding.
- Entry Deadline:** Junior forms must be received by Noon, Monday, June 5.  
Adult forms must be received by Noon, Tuesday, June 6.

Jackie was born February 21, 1982, in Bismarck to Celia (Cec) and Jerry Dockter. She attended Northridge Elementary, Cathedral, and St Mary's Central High School. She was a member of the National Honor Society and, in addition to being a member of the St Mary's tennis team, was a cheerleader for the boys' basketball team and captain of the football cheerleading squad. In her senior year she was elected St. Mary's Homecoming Queen.

Jackie died November 3, 1999, at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester, Minnesota, six weeks after being diagnosed with a brain tumor.

Jackie was known for her tennis accomplishments both on and off the court. She was the West Region Girls' Singles Champion in 1999 and placed third in the North Dakota State Girls' Tennis Tournament. Her love for children was apparent when she taught summer lessons for the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District.

What Jackie was most known for was how she made people feel. She had a special gift of making people laugh with her quick wit. Her enthusiasm for life crossed school boundaries. She made friends with so many, not only in the Bismarck/Mandan area, but across the entire state. Jackie is missed by many.

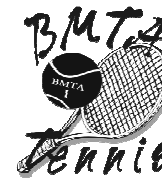
