YOU'VE MADE IT TO SECTIONALS-NOW WHAT?

Get ready for the big event by checking the following:

Player Eligibility: Check with your District League Coordinator to verify your team's eligibility. Participants must have played two (2) matches through District Championships to be eligible to compete at the Sectional Championship. USTA League Regulation 2.03A(3)

USTA Membership: Your USTA memberships must be current through the last day of championship play. Any expired memberships or memberships expiring during the championship must be renewed prior to playing at the Sectional Championship. Players can renew or check expiration dates at **www.membership.usta.com.**

NTRP Level: All individual team members must be from the appropriate level of play in accordance with the NTRP system.

Team Eligibility: Each team must have a minimum number of eligible players to compete at the Sectional Championships. USTA League Regulation 2.03A(5).

Player Roster: Your District League Coordinator will send your team roster to the Section Office for you.

Tournament Handbook: Includes hotel and court information and times and location of captain's meeting. It also has directions and tournament procedures.

Match Schedule: View your Sectional Championship match schedule. Schedules are posted approximately 7-10 days prior to event.

Online Team Registration: Completing this process officially registers your team and notifies tournament officials and committee that your team will be participating. Team captains must register their team within 7 days of completion of their district championship.

Host Hotel: To help you enjoy the event, we have established special room rates for your team at the host hotel. Some of the benefits with staying at the host holes include: meeting other teams and close proximity to courts.

Captain's Meeting (Conference Call): To help you be prepared, please keep the following in mind. The captain's meeting will be for captains and co-captains only. This meeting will take place in a conference call format with all primary communication taking place via email. Players will have the opportunity to ask tournament staff and officials questions. Captain's conference call phone number is located in the Tournament Handbook.

2014 Sectional Championship Entry Fees:

* No later than seven days after completion of district championship or local league, each team which qualifies to compete in the Section Championship must notify the District League Coordinator that it will or will not participate in the tournament. District League Coordinator must in turn, notify the Section League Coordinator of teams attending Sectional Championship. If a team gives notice that it will participate but then fails to do so, penalties may be administered with the maximum penalty being disqualification of all its members who had agreed to participate from all league play for the following year. The Championship Committee named for the event where the violation occurs shall decide upon the penalty. This decision may be appealed to the ITA Section League Grievance Committee.
