



FACILITY SEARCH FOR LEAGUE PLAYERS



Click on "Facility Search"






Enter the Facility Name. Enter the State. (If you enter only, "State: Washington," all facilities in Washington State will populate the list.) I entered "Bally" for this example and Washington State. Then I clicked on "Search" and the list of five Bally facilities populated. (The last one is a duplicate of the third because Olympia Bally had two USTA facility numbers over the years.)




Click on one of the facilities and a list of players who ever played on a USTA league team at that facility will populate.



The Year End Rating Date will indicate the last year the player played three or more matches in the past three years. If there is not a date, then they have not been given a dynamic rating in the past three years. Some players listed have moved, registered with a new USTA number, or died but not deleted from the Facility's list. You can click on each name to view where the players have last played and the leagues they played.

Copy the list and paste it to an Excel worksheet.
You can do that for all the facilities you are searching, adding each to the list.



- Save the worksheet.
- Remove duplicates¹ (an Excel function),
- Sort the data by city, gender, level or other chosen criteria.


¹ Players are listed on each facility's list for which the player ever played on a team, not necessarily a member.

ADVANCED SEARCH

Under the Advanced Search, you select the degree of detail—all players in an Area, by level, by gender, by league played. The menu is Drill-down. After one selection, another selection option, and continue until you see Gender and Level.



You may view the list of players in the entire SW Washington Area or request by League (optional) and now select Gender and/or Level. Note: I leave League unselected to view the broadest number of players. If you are forming a Mixed Doubles team you might want to leave Gender as "All" and enter one specific Level, e.g., 3.5. You can go back and broaden your search or be more specific.



The following list is for Gender: Male Level: 2.5. You can print this report. You can copy and paste the results to a spreadsheet if you want to save it, sort, delete, or modify portions of the list.
