



## Roger Federer Withdraws from Western & Southern Open

**CINCINNATI (Aug. 5, 2021)** – Seven-time Western & Southern Open champion **Roger Federer** has withdrawn from the 2021 tournament due to a knee injury.

A 20-time Major champion, Federer is the winningest player at the Western & Southern Open with a 47-10 record. The most recent of his record seven championships came in 2015 when he successfully defended his title.

Six former men's champions remain entered in the Western & Southern Open, including two-time champions **Novak Djokovic** (2020, 2018) and **Andy Murray** (2011, 2008) along with **Daniil Medvedev** (2019), **Grigor Dimitrov** (2017), **Marin Cilic** (2016) and **Rafael Nadal** (2013). The women's field will feature five past champions, including two-time winners **Serena Williams** (2015, 2014) and **Victoria Azarenka** (2020, 2013) as well as **Madison Keys** (2019), **Garbine Muguruza** (2017) and **Karolina Pliskova** (2016).
