Ranking System

Players earn a rank in each of the three levels of competition. Points are tallied up over a 12 month period and players receive a ranking for these points at each level. The three levels of competition are District, Sectional, and National.

District ranking points are awarded for Level 6 tournaments and higher. District rankings are determined by the top 4 events played in a 12 Month Rolling Stand.

Sectional ranking points are awarded for Level 5 tournaments and higher. Sectional rankings are determined by the top 5 events played in a 12 Month Rolling Stand.

National ranking points are awarded for Level 3 tournaments and higher. National rankings are determined by the top 6 events played in a 12 Month Rolling Stand.

Points Per Round Ranking system

This is a method of ranking players or teams that is based on earning ranking points for the round reached, and in some cases, for wins over highly ranked players or teams. Points Per Round are the ranking points that are awarded in a Points Per Round Ranking System
