Upcoming Changes for USTA Southern Mixed Doubles League Program in 2024

USTA Southern will change to "straight" NTRP levels for the 2024 League Championship Year.

NTRP Divisions Offered: 2.5, 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, 5.0

Reasons for the Change:

League participation in USTA Southern Mixed Doubles has declined by

12% over the past 10 years.

Self ("S"), Appealed ("A") and Mixed-Exclusive ("M") rated players will be subject to dynamic disqualification during Mixed Doubles league play beginning in 2024.

Players closer in skill level during a match will generate better NTRP

calculations.

More competitive matches for "Straight" NTRP levels to ensure our mission of fair-based play.

Largest number of NTRP Grievances, self-rate complaints and self-rate abuse in USTA Southern comes from the Mixed Doubles League program with the current combined NTRP levels.

Kev Notes:

 Players may still play "up" one NTRP level, similar to the Adult League program. For example, a 3.0 player may compete on both 3.0 and/or 3.5 Mixed Doubles team.

Opportunities for advancement are still in place. Eligible teams may compete through the USTA National Mixed Doubles League

Championship.
