#### **Spirit of Gongs**

#### A Beautiful Collection of the Most Musical Gongs

Gongs are mainly found in East and Southeast Asia. They are typically made of a flat metal plate, are various shapes and are struck with a mallet. As gongs are created in many sizes, we've focused on the most musical - middle to small-sized [5-26 inches].

We aimed for the best quality possible, recording the entire library at 24 bit / 96 kHz utilizing the best available ADCs and we believe the natural essence of these rich percussive instruments has been faithfully preserved as a result.

# A Meticulous Recording Process for Intuitive Tools and Faithful Sounds

Depending on the particular gong, we were able to record multiple velocity layers. In addition, we assessed the perceptual tonality of each sample allowing them to be played on the keyboard intuitively and in key. The result is a more than just a library of gong sounds; its versatile instrument capable of creating lengthy metallic textures, large metallic hits and magnificent musical bell and chime tones.

The library has been sorted by country of origin, and includes 80 gongs from Burma, Cambodia, China, Indochina, Japan, Malaysia and Vietnam. Photos and physical specifications accompany the majority of presets.



# Interface



#### 1 Product info

This panel shows details and images for each soundbank or the instrument

#### 2 > Amplitude

» VEL

Adjust the filter velocity sensitivity

» ADSR

Attack, decay, sustain, release controls

#### 3 Filter

» Filter Type

Multimode filter can be set to low-pass (LP), band-pass (BP), or high-pass (HP)

» ENV

Depth of the filters EG

» CUT

Filter cutoff frequency

» RES

Filter resonance amount

» VEL

Adjust the filter velocity sensitivity

» ADSR

Attack, decay, sustain, release controls

#### 4 Drive

- » On/Off Switch
- » Amount

Sets the drive amount

#### 5 Play

» Polyphony

Number of keys that can sound at once

» Monophonic

Override polyphony - one key sounds

» Glide

Severity between note transition

NOTE: only works within Monophonic

» Velocity Curve

Adjust the play velocity sensitivity

#### 6 LFO

» Type

Select from square, triangle, etc.

» Rate

Set the LFO speed

» Depth

Place LFO variance from low to high

#### 7 Transpose

» Bend

Pitch levels assigned to the modwheel

» Semitone

Medium-level transpose

» Finetone

Transpose in cents

Drive

Adjust the overdrive amount of the Bit Crusher effect

#### 8 Pitch Env

» Depth

Establish the intensity of the pitch change to occur

» Time

Establish the time it takes for the pitch envelope to complete

#### 9 Modulations

» Pitch, Pan, Filter, Amp

Apply modulations, including envelopes, velocities, LFOs and more—set the ranges and rates for each modulation
