A successful organization obviously relies heavily on the investment of the community. Donors, volunteers and partners of the United Way of the Lowcountry annually come together to help us provide the services and programs so many in the lowcountry rely on.

In 2013, these programs—whether one of our partner agencies, our Early Grade Reading Program, or our Helpline, we helped over 31,500 people in the lowcountry improve their situations.

Progress is constantly moving toward a destination, and in the last year we were able to take progressive steps in improving the health, education, income and basic needs of our community. We helped fund 44 programs and 33 partner agencies. In addition, we saw over 1800 people come in or call for help, and we aimed for positive outcomes with all of them.

Our Early Grade Reading program saw sustained success in 2013. With the help of nearly 200 volunteer tutors we enrolled well over 200 students in eight local schools in our program. Of these students, 98% in Beaufort County and 95% in Jasper County improved their MAP test scores in reading—an incredible success rate we look to duplicate next year!

Only the businesses and individuals of Beaufort and Jasper Counties who recognized the United Way as a positive solution to many problems in these areas of focus made it possible for us to take these steps. Our donors and volunteers should feel fully staked in this successful journey.

EARLY GRADE READING

In the 2013-2014 school year, a total of 309 students in eight local schools participated in the Early Grade Reading initiative. Both Beaufort and Jasper County schools use MAP testing as a way to assess core reading knowledge in elementary students. A full 98% of students in Beaufort and 95% in Jasper participating in the program raised their test scores by the end of the year.

While we have even more numbers to share, success isn't solely measured by numbers on a page. Numbers represent people like Dylan, a second-grader on Hilton Head. Dylan enrolled in our program in first grade, and like many others he increased his test scores in reading. Just as valuable as learning to read, however, is the fact that with one-on-one time with a tutor, he increased his confidence in himself.

"This program gave him the ability to sit down and understand his way of learning," said his mom, Sarah. "We couldn't be happier with the results."

Tutors, obviously play a crucial role in the success of the Early Grade Reading Program, and in the 2013-2014 school year they were boosted by the presence of over 25 AmeriCorps volunteers.

AmeriCorps members have provided stability, and each year new members take an oath to continue to provide quality service to the students they serve.

The Early Grade Reading Program continues to expand the scope of the program as we add volunteers and enroll more students in need. We continue to run the program in the following schools:

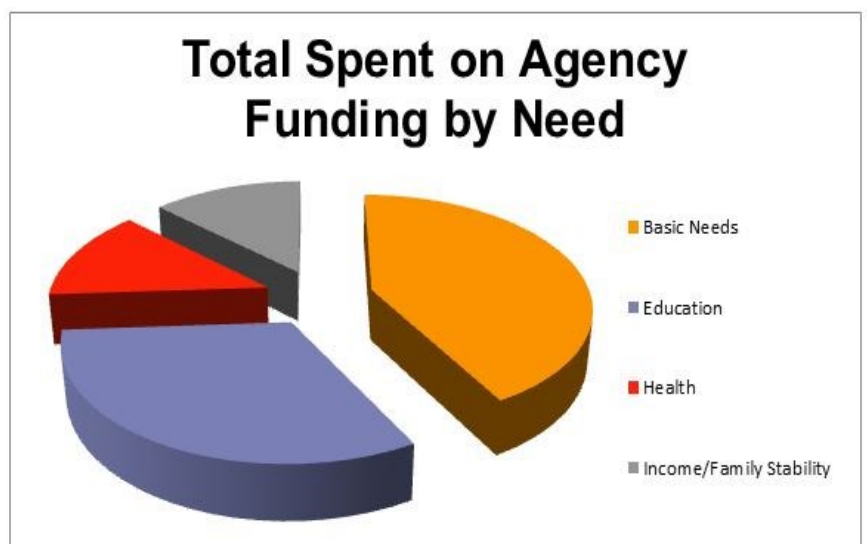

HELPLINE

In addition to Early Grade Reading and Community Investment, United Way of the Low-country also runs a Helpline for both direct services and referrals. Because people like you gave over two million dollars last year, we answered over **1,400 phone calls** and received **423 walk-ins** looking for help. That financial support helped people like Kacie O'Loughlin, whose son Paxton was born with a condition that left him with weak neck muscles. As a result of his inability to move his head, he developed a soft spot on his skull that, without correction, would lead to permanent affliction.

Kacie and her husband both work full-time, but the helmet Paxton needed was not covered by insurance, and the cost far exceeded their savings. With nowhere else to turn Kacie called the United Way, where we were able to coordinate with three other partner agencies to help Paxton get the care he needed. Today, with therapy, Paxton has a prognosis for a full recovery.

Paxton is not alone—many in need of assistance with food, housing, child care, credit counseling, support groups, disaster services and more will enter our doors or call our number in 2015. With your continued support we will meet the challenges of our community as they come.
