Welcome! You are invited to attend this free public lecture series on animal shelter medicine. The Shelter Medicine Elective course provides an introduction to the specific concerns faced by animal shelters today. Through weekly presentations and discussions led by experts in the field, attendees will be able to identify key concepts to animal sheltering, create informed strategies for solutions to problems shelters may face, and recognize how everyone can be involved in shelters and communities in saving the lives of homeless animals.

We invite non-registered students, shelter staff and volunteers, and members of the community to participate in lectures in person or online. The Shelter Medicine Elective course meets once weekly for one 60-minute lecture, with optional free lunch provided during lectures. Lectures are in a presenter-led format with time for discussion and Q&A after each presentation. Most presentations will be recorded and posted online.
