

Duties of Associational Mission VBS Director

In most associations, the associational mission VBS director is responsible to the associational Sunday School director for these duties:

1. Encourage churches to enlist a Backyard Bible Club/mission VBS director who will receive training in an associational mission VBS clinic or in other special conferences.
2. Work with the associational director of missions and/or the associational missions committee to locate sites, promote these projects, and coordinate Backyard Bible Clubs and mission VBS work.
3. Provide training for church leaders with a mission VBS clinic or with customized training.
4. Become familiar with additional resources such as E-Anytime-Anywhere for preschoolers and children (available at www.lifeway.com) that could be used in mission VBS or Bible clubs.
5. Enlist, as needed, other team members to assist in a mission VBS clinic.
6. Assist mission VBS age-group leaders with interpretation of materials and clinic plans.
7. Conduct model Backyard Bible Clubs or mission Vacation Bible Schools, using selected team members to help.
8. Utilize associational mission VBS team members to help churches conduct Backyard Bible Clubs and mission VBS.
9. Make full reports to the associational VBS director.
