

VBS 2013 Grice Memorial Mission VBS Offer

The Grice Memorial Mission Vacation Bible School Fund* exists to provide teaching resources for churches and missions conducting VBS as an evangelistic outreach ministry to underprivileged families.

Church's Obligations

To qualify for free resources, a church must agree to:

- Use them in Bible study and ministry with underprivileged children and their families;
- Plan for appropriate follow-up to each prospect and for each decision made; and
- Send a report of each school to the LifeWay VBS Ministry Specialist at the address given on the back of this brochure.

Priority for this offer will be given to churches and missions attempting to reach families in their own communities. The amount of free resources provided will depend on the number of requests and the availability of funds. Applications are granted beginning February 15 of each year in the order they are received. Requests from groups desiring resources for use as part of a mission trip will be considered only if funds are available after all other requests have been met.

Application Procedures

To receive the free VBS resources:

- Legibly complete the attached application;
- Determine and indicate the preferred theme: Colossal Coaster World or Club VBS: Jungle Janut**;
- Indicate the number of workers that will need teaching resources for each age group;
- Estimate the number of students expected in each age group to receive Activity Paks or Daily Park Guides; and
- Mail the request in an envelope to the address given on the back of this brochure.

Reporting Your VBS

Upon completion of your VBS, please send a report with the following information:

- Name of sponsoring church/mission;
- Contact information (including name, address, telephone number, and email);
- Date(s) of the school(s);
- Location(s) of the school(s);
- Number enrolled in school(s);
- Average attendance of school(s);
- Number of prospects discovered (including family members);
- Summary of follow-up procedures being used; and
- Summary of how the free VBS resources were used.

In addition to this report, information should be compiled and reported on the regular VBS report form.

*The Grice Memorial Scholarship is a trust fund administered by the Southern Baptist Foundation. Interest from this trust (approximately \$3,000.00 each year) is used as directed by the estate of Homer L. and Ethel Grice to provide free VBS resources to Southern Baptist churches and established missions. Resources must be used to conduct VBS to reach economically disadvantaged communities and people groups.
