Purpose Statement

During this session leaders will be introduced to the 2013 LifeWay Club VBS Jungle Jaunt™ Worship Rally, craft, snacks, recreation, adult and mission materials.

Focal Wall Description

Create a jungle atmosphere with jungle objects (vine, rope, monkeys) hanging from the ceiling, placed on walls or floor. Hang Jungle Jaunt™ Banner or project logo from Overhead Cell Pack. You also have the option of making a sign by projecting the logo on paper, foam board canvas tarp and painting.

Room Setup Description

- Arrange chairs as if it were a Worship Center
- Place Jungle Jaunt™ Extras handout and pen/pencil in each chair
- Display Jungle Jaunt™ materials and resources on tables
- Display rotation site materials you have prepared
- Put banner and/or posters on wall
- Place markers and tear sheets in a wooden crate or basket
- Place supplies for activities to be used by conferees in a wooden crate or basket

Decoration Suggestions

Set up room to resemble a jungle with hanging vines, colorful foliage and extra large butterflies. Additional decorating ideas can be found on page 53 of the Administrative Guide. Additional resources can be found at party stores and websites, discount stores and teacher supply stores.

- TV/DVD
- CD player
- Laptop (optional)

Teaching Steps

Step 1 Arrival

- Greet conferees and ask them to line up outside conference room door.
- Assign conferees to age groups.
- Hand out age graded signs.
- Choose two flag bearers and a Bible bearer.
- Play theme music as conferees enter the room.

Step 2 Welcome

- Instruct conferees to sit down or use sit down chord.

- Welcome the conferees using the Worship Rally Guide, page 11, Jaunt 1: One Amazing Creator comments.
- Say the Jungle Jaunt™ Motto together.

Step 3 Music

- Sing “Jehovah Jireh” using Worship Rally DVD.

Step 4 Scripture and Prayer

- Lead the conferees in reading together the Jungle Jaunt™ Scripture, Psalm 145:1 – 2: “I exalt You, my God the King, and praise Your name for ever and ever. I will praise You every day; I will honor Your name forever and ever.”
- Pray - using the suggestion for daily prayer on page 17 of the Worship Rally Guide.

Step 5 Worship Rally and Offering

- Play Day 1 of the Worship Rally Drama found on the Worship Rally DVD.
- Following the Drama, using the Worship Rally Guide, page 21, read Jaunt 1.
- Play softly “Lord of All” while discussing Offering options found on page 27 of the Worship Rally Guide.

Step 6 Evangelistic Emphasis

- Remind conferees of the importance of an evangelistic emphasis during the week and that VBS is the largest evangelistic outreach we have in our churches.
- Point out pg. 28 of the Worship Rally Guide.
- Share your testimony .
- Explain the ABCs of Becoming a Christian – Worship Rally Guide, page 30.
- Draw attention to pages 42 – 44 of the Administrative Guide.

Step 7 Music

- Sing “He Made a Way” using Worship Rally DVD.

Step 8 Adult Jungle Jaunt™ Materials

- Bring attention to the Jungle Jaunt™ Adult Bible Study material that is a free downloadable from www.lifeway.com/clubvbs.
- Briefly discuss advantages of Adult Bible Study in conjunction with VBS.
- Briefly discuss ways the material can be used effectively to meet the needs of the churches.

Step 9 Missions Materials

- Bring attention to the Jungle Jaunt™ Missions material that is a free downloadable from www.lifeway.com/clubvbs.
- Briefly discuss ways the material can be expanded.
- Prior to the conference, research countries, missionaries and volunteers being highlighted.

Step 10 Craft Cove Rotation

- Make examples of each craft for the conferees to see (optional).
- Draw attention to craft items on display.
- Give a brief explanation and tips for making the craft items.
- Allow each conferee to make one of the crafts. Choose a craft that is quick and easy to assemble. (Example: Day 3, pg. 61, Administrative Guide, Bark Cloth Prayer Journal)

Step 11 Snack Shack Rotation

- Display snack items for conferees to see and/or taste.
- Draw conferees attention to the snack items on display .
- Give a brief explanation and tips for the suggested daily snacks to prepare - as described on p. 84 of Administrative Guide.
- Allow each conferee to make one of the snacks or have a snack premade. Choose a snack that will be quick to make and easy to transport as you travel. (Example: Day 4, p. 87, Administrative Guide: Toucan Treats)

Step 12 Recreation Rapids Rotation

- If space allows, provide recreation equipment for the conferees to try some of the games found in the Administrative Guide, p. 72.
- Give a brief explanation of the suggested daily indoor and outdoor recreation games.
- Point out that the recreation suggestions and supply list can be found in the Administrative Guide, p. 71.

Step 13 Closing

- Have conferees stand.
- Make any announcements or closing comments as suggested on p. 27 of Worship Rally Guide.
- Dismiss in prayer.
- Play Jungle Jaunt™ theme song as conferees leave.
