Internship description

Internship level and scope

This internship is aimed at university-level students with experience in software design, coding and debugging. This knowledge is essential for all applicants. Experience gained in the classroom and through personal application will be accepted.

The internship requires a minimum commitment of 10 hours per week for a duration of three months.
