Dear High School Athletes, Parents, Coaches and Athletic Trainers:

You are receiving this information because you or your child attends a high school that participates in the Georgia High School Association, and may be eligible to participate in a survey evaluating concussion legislation in Georgia.

Recently, there have been significant changes in concussion management in youth and high school sports in Georgia, and we are seeking to determine how these changes have been adopted and put into practice.
