## Liberty Union High School Athletic Hall of Fame

The following procedures shall be observed in administering the Liberty Union Athletic Hall of Fame Award:

- A) The selection committee shall consist of the administrators, staff members, Hall of Fame members, and community members whose responsibility shall be the following:
  - 1. Secure names and appropriate information regarding those to be considered as candidates.
  - 2. Meet to review potential Hall of Fame candidates.
  - 3. Select those to be inducted into the Hall of Fame based upon the criteria outlined in Section B.
- B) The criteria for eligibility and selection to be considered into the Liberty Union High School Athletic Hall of Fame shall be as follows:
  - 1. Athletic candidate(s) being considered must be out of school for a period of five years.
  - 2. Candidates(s) from all sports will be considered.
  - 3. Candidates(s) must be a Liberty Union High School graduate.
  - 4. Candidates(s) who are not Liberty Union High School graduates may be considered under special circumstances.
  - 5. Candidate(s) must be of good character.
  - 6. Because of the subjective nature of evaluating achievements of athletes, there will be no specific criteria for selection to the Hall of Fame. The committee is given broad discretion in its selections; however, the major factors to be considered are as follows:
    - a) The candidate's overall contribution to the Liberty Union Athletic Program.
    - b) The candidate(s) should have earned all district level recognition or equivalent recognition.
    - c) The candidate's achievements following graduation from high school.
    - d) The candidate is a positive role model in the community.
- C) The total number of inductees to be taken in each year is to be determined by the selection committee.
- D) **Awards:** An appropriate plaque shall be given to the inductee as well as a lifetime pass to Liberty Union athletic events. Another plaque will be displayed on the Athletic Wall of Fame.
- E) **Time of Induction:** The time of induction into the Hall of Fame shall be set by the Athletic Director and shall be such as to give proper respect and the ceremonies shall be such, that it shall be appropriate with the honor and dignity that goes with the induction.

F) Securing and Maintaining the names to be considered for induction into the Hall of Fame:

Names will be submitted through the Athletic Director and a full report consisting of names, sports participated in, character references, and all other pertinent information shall be included. The candidate must submit his/her information to the Athletic Director in a timely manner.

The committee shall review each candidate and select those names to be added to the "Active Candidates" list. From this list of active candidates, the Hall of Fame selection committee shall select the Hall of Fame inductee(s) each year.

The "Active Candidate" list will be maintained by the Athletic Director. Thus, candidates who are added each year to the list will be kept for consideration in future years.

G) By a majority vote of the selection committee, a Hall of Fame member may be removed from the Liberty Union High School Hall of Fame. Hall of Fame members must always serve as a role model to the student body.
