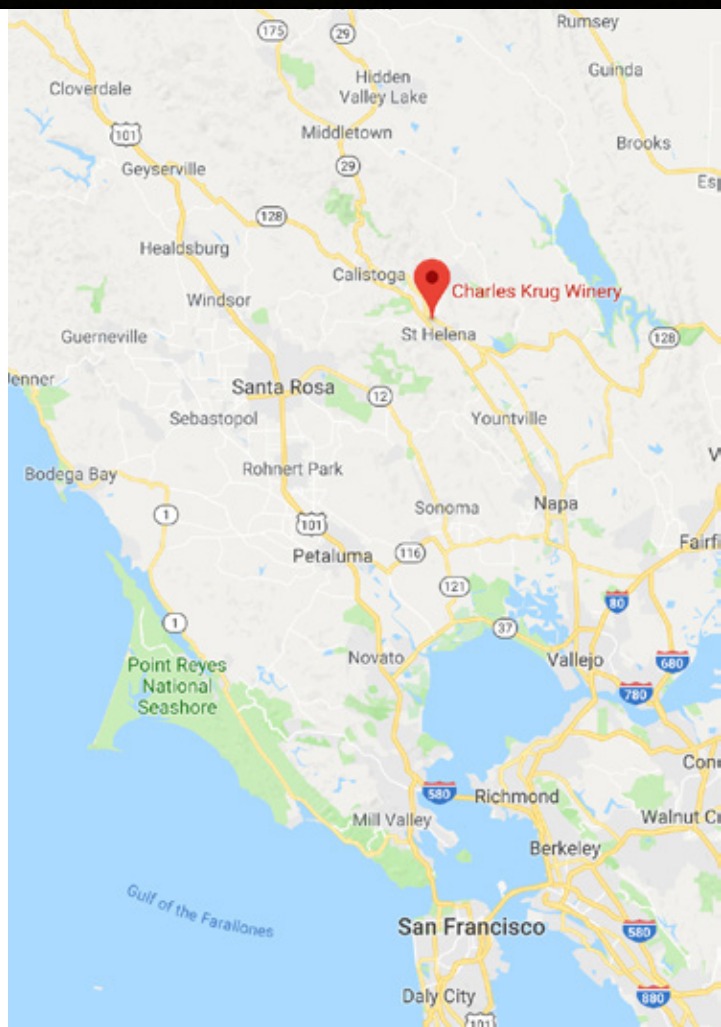

SONOMA COUNTY AIRPORT [STS]

20 miles from Napa Valley offering non-stop flights from Los Angeles, San Francisco, Portland (Oregon), San Diego, Phoenix, Seattle, Santa Ana

SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT [SFO]

85 miles from Napa Valley
