Wawa, PA (March 27, 2020) – In addition to enhanced cleaning and sanitations protocols and previously implemented in-store precautions, Wawa is now adding extra measures to ensure stores are supporting the most up-to-date recommendations from the CDC and other health officials, with a specific focus on social distancing.

As the situation surrounding COVID-19 has continued to evolve, Wawa has already begun asking customers and associates to maintain a distance of 6 ft. from each other inside the store supported through helpful in-store signage, announcements and videos. As part of that, Wawa is rapidly enhancing and reinforcing this effort with visual floor markers to support maintaining a healthy distance. That also includes new distancing aids, in the form of clear, plastic shields, featured at our check-out counters.

Chainwide roll outs are in progress. These distance markers will be featured in all Wawa stores on or before March 30. Additionally, customer checkout counter shields will be in all stores on or before April 3.
