# WEST COAST CONFERENCE GOLF

## MEN'S HISTORY

The West Coast Conference has sponsored a men's golf championship since 1969, with Pepperdine leading the way with 16 titles. The Waves have claimed 14 WCC championships since 1990 and took home the NCAA championship title in 1997. During their amazing run, the Waves were led by a pair of Byron Nelson Award winners in Jason Allred, the inaugural winner in 2002, and Michael Putnam, who took home the award in 2005.

In 2009 at the Hiddenbrooke gold Course, San Francisco captured its first men's title since 1990. The Dons' Domingo Jojola finished in second place with a score of 210, while teammate Kurt Nino had the lowest single round of the tournament with a 64 on day one. LMU's Greg Moss was the individual champion with a final score of 209, while Pepperdine's Andrew Putnam won WCC Player of the Year honors and San Francisco's Gary Nelson took home the WCC Coach of the Year award.

The 2008 season marked a first for the University of San Diego as it captured the men's title for the first time in school history. The Toreros were led by juniors Jake Yount, who tied for the individual championship and Darrin Hall.

Loyola Marymount, led by then-freshman Brian Locke, captured the school's first-ever WCC Men's Golf Championship in 2006. Locke, who earned WCC Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year honors, led the Lions with a final round and course record 64 in the WCC Championships to win the WCC individual title. In 2006, three WCC teams earned their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance as LMU, the conference automatic qualifier, San Diego and Santa Clara earned NCAA West Regional bids. The Lions, along with Pepperdine, advanced out of the West Regional to compete at the NCAA Championships for the first time in school history.

Pepperdine won six titles in seven years from 1991 through 1997, including a record-low 275 strokes in the third round of the 1992 championship at the Torrey Pines North course in La Jolla, California. The 1992 Waves' three-round total of 855 is a record score which stands to date, aided by Steve Van Alstyne's record-setting 6-under-par score. That same year, the Waves' Todd Andrews struck a championship record 66 in the third round to finish runner-up to his teammate. Portland was the squad which dented Pepperdine's streak, pulling away with the 1993 WCC title. That Pilot squad was led by Paul Hanson, whose 6-over-par score was not enough as he lost the individual title to Saint Mary's Eric Meichtry in the first hole of a sudden-death playoff.

The 1980's were dominated by San Francisco, with the Dons winning six titles in the decade. Mike Fabian was one of the most dominant Dons on the links, placing in the top 10 in 1986 and 1987, and winning the individual title outright in 1988 with a 2-over-par 216. Over the years, more Dons have won nine individual titles, the second highest total among WCC schools, just trailing Pepperdine's total of 10 championship crowns. Portland and Pepperdine were the only other schools which infiltrated the Dons' dynasty, with the Pilots winning their first title at Half Moon Bay in 1985, and the Waves winning their first title at the West Delta Golf Course in Portland in 1987.

Seattle and Nevada-Reno, two schools no longer members of the West Coast Conference, were the most successful schools on the course in the seventies, with Seattle bringing home 5 consecutive titles, while Nevada won three. Seattle's 595 score over 36-holes in 1980 remains the conference record over that distance. San Francisco won their first title in 1971, while in 1970 Santa Clara and Pacific became the only schools ever to split a title. San Jose State won the first WCC golf championship in 1969.

## WOMEN'S HISTORY

With the tremendous golf success in the West Coast Conference over the years, the conference added a women's golf championship beginning in 1997. The title has been the property of Pepperdine and San Francisco during its 13-year history, with the Waves taking home 11 titles and the Dons winning twice. Both schools have finished either first or second in all 13 tournaments.

The trend continued in 2009 as the Waves collected their eighth straight title, while the Dons finished second. Pepperdine's Jayvie Agojo took home her second career individual title with a three-round score of 221. San Francisco's Danielle Cvitanov was named the WCC Player of the Year, while her head coach Ria Quiazon won the WCC Coach of the Year award.

The Waves again dominated the field at the 2008 WCC Championships, taking home their seventh consecutive league title. Pepperdine would advance to the NCAA Central Regionals, finishing twelfth. The previous year, Pepperdine would advance to the NCAA Championships finishing seventh. The seventh-place showing marked the seventh Top 10 finish in eight appearances, and fifth straight for the Waves. Included among the those Top 10 showings, are four Top 5 finishes.

For guiding the Waves to a fourth place finish at the national championship in 2005, Head Coach Laurie Gibbs was honored with National Coach of the Year honors by Golfweek.

In 2003, Pepperdine's Katherine Hull completed a record-breaking season for Pepperdine, as she was named the Division I "Player of the Year" by the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). Hull made history when she shot a record low round of 63, breaking her previous mark of 64 set in 2002. She was also named first team All-American along with teammate Lindsey Wright. It marked the second straight year that Hull was tabbed a first team All-American and first time that Wright earned first team honors. Pepperdine's Wright and Hull, along with USF's Laing earned all-WCC first team honors for the fourth straight year, joining Pepperdine's Jenny Glasgow ('97-'00) as the only women's golfers to accomplish the feat. straight year that Hull was tabbed a first team All-American and first time that Wright earned first team honors. ## 2009 WCC Golf Championships Recap

The USF men captured their first WCC golf title since 1990, finishing just one stroke ahead of Loyola Marymount for the closest finish at the WCC men's golf championships since 1986.

The Dons finished day one with a total score of 565, just four strokes ahead of second place Loyola Marymount, which finished the first two rounds with a score of 569. San Francisco was led on day one by senior Kirt Nino, who finished round two in 64 strokes, the lowest round of the field.

On the final day, Pepperdine freshman Josh Anderson and San Diego senior Blake Trimble finished with the lowest scores of the round, each firing a three-under par 69. Loyola Marymount's Greg Moss earned the tournament's individual title with a three day score of 209 (-7), becoming the third Lion in four years to win the title. San Francisco junior Domingo Jojola improved upon his seventh place finish in 2007, finishing in second with a score of 210 (-6), just one shot behind the leader. Trimble rounded out the top three with a score of 212 (-4). Santa Clara freshman Cory Mehl earned the lowest score in program history at the tournament with a three under 213. Gonzaga sophomore Kyle Huus also joined his school's record book, with the highest finish in school history, tying for fifth place with a score of 214 (-2).

On the women's side, it was the Pepperdine Waves yet again taking home the title. They have now won eight straight and 11 out of the last 12 conference titles on the women's side. The Waves finished the first round ahead of the pack with a 297 first round, followed by a 304 second round, to give them just a two stroke lead on second place San Francisco.

On day three, the Waves came through again, finishing with a third round score of 304, 16 strokes better than the next best team, San Francisco.

The Waves were led by senior Jayvie Agojo, who took home the individual title for the second time in her career, with a three-round score of 221 (+5). She also won back in 2006, her freshman year, when she also shot 221 for the three rounds. Agojo was followed by freshman Kaitlin Drolson, who shot a three-round score of 228 (+12), to tie with Gonzaga's Rachel Sibbitt and Santa Clara's Miki Ueoka for second place overall.

Coming in at second was San Francisco, who shot a three-round score of 923, for its eighth straight runner up finish. The Dons were led by juniors Diana Hong and Danielle Cvitanov, who both finished the tournament with a score of 231 (+15), finishing tied for fifth overall. Sibbitt and Ueoka finished with a score of 228 (+12) to tie for second place, becoming their program's highest finisher in school history at the tournament.

Santa Clara finished with a three-round score of 941 to come in at third place. Gonzaga improved upon its fifth place finish from last year coming in at fourth with a score of 956. Portland rounded out the women's field with a three-round score of 981, to finish in fifth place.



### Gonzaga Bulldogs



★ The Gonzaga men finished 13th at the Braveheart Classic, 3rd at the Bandon Dunes Championship, and 12th at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic for the month of March.

★ SR **Derek Cheney** was the top finisher for the Zags at the Braveheart, finishing tied for 34th with a three round score of 227, and a low round of 73. Cheney and SR **Jason Azzarito** were the top finishers at Bandon Dunes, with both finishing tied for fifth with two round scores of 156.

★ The women had finishes of 4th at the Fresno State Lexus Classic, 16th at the Julie Inkster Spartan Invitational, 5th at the Jackrabbit Invitational, and 9th at the Wyoming Cowgirl Classic in March.

★ FR **Victoria Fallgren** and SO **Stephanie Corey** led the way at the Lexus Classic, tying for 2nd (217) and 16th (225) respectively. At the Jackrabbit Invitational, SO **Jessica Howe** finished tied for 16th with a three round score of 226, while JR **Sage Suffecool** tied for 20th with a score of 227.



### Loyola Marymount Lions

★ The Lions finished fifth at the Braveheart Classic, eighth at the Triumph, and 14th at the Barona Collegiate Cup for the month of March.

★ At the Braveheart Classic, SO **Jake Sarnoff** finished in second place, just two strokes short of the individual title, with a three-round score of 212, four-under par. In the four tournaments played so far, he has posted three top 10 finishes, placing third at the Anteater Invitational, and tied for seventh at the Triumph.

★ At the Barona Cup, FR **Bryan Bergna** paced the Lions, finishing in a tie for 17th place with a three-round score of 219. Sarnoff finished just behind Bergna with a three-round score of 221, good for a tie for 28th place out of the 104 golfers present.

★ The Lions will look to continue their recent history of success at the WCC Golf Championships as they have taken the individual title in three of the last four championships.



### Pepperdine Waves

★ The Pepperdine men finished in the top 6 in three of the four tournaments in March: USC Collegiate Invitational (T4th), Fresno Lexus Classic (6th), General Hackler Championship (4th), and Morris Williams Intercollegiate (4th), and are currently ranked No. 31 in the latest Golfweek rankings.

★ At the General Hackler, which featured five of the top 40 programs in the country, SO **Josh Anderson** tied for first place with a 1-under 215 for the team's first individual title of the Spring.

★ The women are ranked 5th nationally in the latest Golfweek rankings and are led by JR **Taylore Karle** and SO **Lisa McCloskey** who rank 20th and 32nd in the country respectively. McCloskey won the Northrup Grumman Challenge, leading the team to a second place finish, for her fourth top 20 finish, while Karle boasts four top 10 finishes this season.

★ The women have won the last eight individual titles and the Waves are the only women's team with multiple players win the title two or more times.



### Portland Pilots

★ The Pilot men played in three tournaments in March, finishing 11th at the Braveheart Classic, 4th at the Triumph, and 11th at the Oregon Duck Invitational.

★ Junior **Justin Smithisler** and freshman **Nick Chianello** have been leading the way in the Spring as both have recorded a top 10 finish as well as three top 20 finishes. Chianello has the lowest round of the Spring with a 68 at the Oregon Duck Invite.

★ The women have played in two tournaments in the Spring, finishing 3rd at the Red Rocks Invitational and took the consolation trophy at the Lamkin Grip Match Play Championships.

★ SR **Paige Racher** became the first Portland women's golfer to win a tournament individual title, by winning the Red Rocks Invite. with a two-round score of 149.

★ The women closed out the season tied for 21st at the Wyoming Cowgirl Classic.

## Saint Mary's Gaels

★ The Gaels placed fifth at both the Anteater and Callaway Invitational to start the Spring season, before finishing 14th at the Fresno State Lexus Classic and 10th at the Spring Break Championship in the month of March.

★ Seniors **Daniel Cone** and **Robert McCrae** have led the team in the Spring, with both posting two top 20 finishes. Cone placed ninth at the Callaway Invitational and tied for 13th at the Spring Break Championship, while McCrae tied for seventh at the Anteater and 14th at the Callaway.

★ In addition to his top 20 finishes in the Spring, McCrae also boasts several top 10 finishes from the Fall season. In October, he finished third at the Firestone Invitational and fourth at the Del Walker Intercollegiate, before placing seventh at the Pacific Invitational in November.

★ Cone will be the top returner for the Gaels as he finished tied for fifth at last year's WCC golf championships.



## San Diego Toreros

★ The 26th ranked Toreros have won four of their six tournaments in the Spring, winning the San Diego Intercollegiate, the Callaway Invitational, the Mardi Gras Invitational, and tying for first at the Fresno State Lexus Classic.

★ Four Toreros have won individual titles in tournaments this year. SO **Alex Ching** won the Mardi Gras Invitational, SO **Joe Harrison** won the Kauai Collegiate in October, JR **Kenneth McCready** took first at the San Diego Intercollegiate, and JR **Gunner Wiebe** took first at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic.

★ In addition to its top finishes in the Spring, San Diego also won the Kauai Collegiate and placed second at the Wolf Pack Classic in October, and third at the Saint Mary's invitational in November.

★ The Toreros finished second at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic and rank 29th in the latest Golfweek rankings.



## San Francisco Dons

★ The Don men finished in the top 10 in two of its four tournaments played in the Spring, placing second at the Triumph and tying for seventh at the Oregon Duck Invitational.

★ The men had five players finish in the top 20 at the Triumph, led by SR **Domingo Jojola** (3rd) and SR **Chris Cunningham** (4th).

★ The women finished in the top 10 in all four tournaments this Spring, placing second at the Anteater Invitational, third at the Dr. Donnis Thompson Invitational, seventh at the Juli Inkster Invitational, and ninth at the Southern California Intercollegiate.

★ SR **Danielle Cvitanov** led the Dons with two top 10 finishes in the Fall and three top 20 finishes in a row to close out the Spring season, including a 14th place at the Dr. Donnis Thompson.

★ The women rank 41st nationally in the latest Golfweek rankings.



## Santa Clara Broncos

★ The men tied for 1st at the Anteater Invitational to open the Spring season, before placing 7th at the USD Farms Invitational, 3rd at the Braveheart Classic, 10th at the Oregon Duck Invitational, and 11th at the BancorpSouth.

★ JR **Scott Travers** has placed in the top 10 in all but two of the tournaments in the Fall/Spring seasons combined, including second place finishes at the Wyoming Desert and the Del Walker, and a third place finish at the BancorpSouth.

★ The women played in four tournaments in the Spring, placing 10th at the Peg Barnard Invitational, tying for 5th at the Fresno State Lexus Classic, 12th at the Juli Inkster Invitational, and 13th at the Anteater Invitational.

★ JR **Miki Ueoka** placed in the top 20 in five of the six tournaments in the Fall/Spring seasons, including tying for 6th at the Lexus Classic and 7th at the Peg Barnard Invitational.

## DID YOU KNOW ...

There have been four WCC championships that required a sudden death playoff to determine the individual champion. The first playoff occurred in 1974, when Seattle University's Kevin Bishop won the title on the second hole of a playoff while UNLV's Jerry Webber finished second and Santa Clara's Don Dormer finished third; the three had each hit 142 strokes over 36 holes at two-under-par.

The next year (1975), Seattle's Ed Jonson inched out his teammate Rob Watson for the championship (each had swung 147 over 36 holes at plus-three).

In 1993, Saint Mary's Eric Meichtry parred the first hole of his sudden death playoff with Portland's Paul Hanson to become the Gaels' second WCC individual champion (222 strokes over 54 holes; +6).

In 1999, a playoff was needed in the women's event for the first time, as Pepperdine's Nadina Taylor parred the first extra hole to edge past teammate Ramie Takahashi for the crown.



## DID YOU KNOW ...

The 2010 West Coast Conference Women's Golf Championship marks the 14th year of the event. Only two league members have won the women's golf championship, making it arguably the most exclusive championship in the conference.

Pepperdine University won 11 of the previous 13 championships, including the last eight. The University of San Francisco is the only other school to have won the championship, taking home the inaugural crown in 1997 and again in 2001.

The WCC Women's Golf Championship individual medalist honor features three multiple winners. Six individuals have claimed the previous 10 medalist honors. Former Pepperdine All-American Carolina Llano (2003-05) won a record three individual medalist titles in her career. She joins former Waves' Jayvie Agojo (2009, 06) and All-American Lindsey Wright (2002, 00) as the only golfers in WCC history to have won multiple individual medalist honors in the women's championship.

USF is the only other school to boast a WCC Women's Golf Championship individual medalist (Emilie Arnaud - 2001; Maria Borjesson - 1997).





### USF men win 1st title since 1990, PEP women win 8th straight

The University of San Francisco men's team won its first ever conference title at the WCC Golf Championships in Vallejo, CA, while the Pepperdine women's team captured the title for the eighth straight year and its eleventh in the past thirteen.

USF, led by Domingo Jojola, made its move in the second round (271), 10 strokes ahead of the next best team, and just edged out Loyola Marymount by one stroke. Don's Kurt Nino had the lowest round of the tournament with a 64 on day one.

Pepperdine was led by Jayvie Agojo, who won her second career individual title. Pepperdine won the opening (297) and third rounds (304) to run away with the title, finishing 18 strokes ahead of second place San Francisco (923).

Award winners for the men were Andrew Putnam, PEP (player of the year) and Alex Ching, USD (freshman of the year). For the women, Danielle Cvitanov, USF, took home player of the year, while Lisa McCloskey, PEP, was tabbed freshman of the year.
