Getting Godliness Right:

Godliness is a general word that summarizes the behavior expected of a Christian.

Godliness means to be moral, but it doesn't mean moralistic.

- Moral: living by God's standards
- Moralism: practicing morality distinct from God's grace. Matt 7:3; 23:4 & 5; Rom 1:17

The gospel without godliness emphasizes grace with no sense of living our lives as God intends. 2Pet 3:11

Godliness without the <u>gospel</u> imposes a moral standard on those who don't know the God of the standard.

John 8; 2Tim 3:5

God gives us the <u>power</u> to live godly lives but it requires <u>human effort</u>.

1Thess 5:24; 1Tim 4:7-8; 2Pet 1:3

Godliness is an <u>appealing</u> virtue.

John 14:9; 2Pet 1:8

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
